As we plan for moving towards the half ice hockey for the 2019-2020 season I would like to propose that SCMH investigate the possibility of purchasing rink dividers that are more suited for this division. Currently on the Hockey Canada website they have 2 listed companies that supply such a product. I have attached their quotes to this report. Athletica comes in at \$6800 plus ~ 500 for shipping PLUS TAXES (requires 4x8' storage space). Omnisport comes in at ~ 8100 Taxes and shipping included.

Cost appears to be very similar. There is no real way to compare the two products. Product videos for installation/take down don't exist.

- Given the sizeable dollar amount of the purchase do we need a small group to decide on which product to buy?
