Meeting called to order at 7:02 PM

Welcome everyone.

Motion to adopt the agenda by Jason, seconded by Butter, All in Favor.

Motion to adopt the last meetings minutes by Chad K, Second by Lori Langen, All in favor.

Division Reports-

T-Ball/Rally Cap- Nothing new.

T-ball- 4 teams with 10 players each.

R/C- 8 teams, some with 10 players, some with 11. Rally Cap starts next week. There will be a coaches meeting next week.

T-ball is Monday and Wednesdays at 5:30-6:30.

Rally Cap is Monday/Wednesday and Tuesday/Thursdays at 5:30-6:30.

11U- 75 total. We were able to secure a 4th head coach with 8-9 assistant coaches. There will be 4 teams with 12-13 kids per team.

Evaluations are on Wednesday night. Practices will start on Monday, and games will start on May 6th.

The 11U player that asked to move down to 9U has decided to stay in 11U after evaluations.

The Beechy kids are coming here.

11U will start with a count of 1 ball, 1 strike. We would consider a 1 ball, 0 strike count, however need to talk with Baseball Sask.

AA and AAA are underway with indoor practices. The AAA schedule is set, and the AA is almost finalized.

13U- 44 total. We had Jeremy Morin step up to help coach 1 of the A teams. There will be 10 on each team. The Elks schedule is done.

No evaluations were done as there was no time.

15U- AAA- May 5 is their league start date.

AA- final cuts after tonight's practice. They need reduce their number from 17-14. We will see if the 3 that don't make the AA cut would like to play 13U A?

AA- home tournament is full.

18U- nothing new. Still have our head coach and 3 assistant coaches.

Cage jackets- some coaches still need to get measured for coach's jackets at Southwest Sports Excellence.

Elk's League-Dave and Chad D attended. There were no issues and the meeting was quick. Next year will be by zoom.

11U- 15 teams- 8 games

13U- 6 teams

15U- 4-5 teams

18U- 4 teams

Registration- 1 parent asked to register 2 players, however we are closed in those divisions.

We are at the exact same number as last year.

Umpire Assignor-

Please get all rosters and schedules to Quinton as he has to manually input all teams and schedules in.

All coaches also need to sign up for RAMP.

Sponsorship- Erin Soos has graciously taken on the sponsorship role.

Some questions- if the A team finds a sponsor, who gets that money- it can be used if that team wants to go to a tournament or provincials, the rest stays with SCMBA.

Last year around \$6000.00 was brought in from sponsorship.

Teams are unable to make money off the sponsorships. Any extra money above the normal expenses will be refunded back to SCMBA to go towards upgrades. We will require a minimum \$250/player.

We ask managers to make a wish list for any extra money, examples- sweaters, pizza parties

Budgets need to be in by May 1st so we can approve them.

In the future, we may have all Grand Slam sponsors go through SCMB. We may ask for a 3 year commitment to the team, and can start advertising for the team in January.

Corrections in the sponsorship form- add a 3'X4' sign under the double sponsor, and remove home run and centerfield for this year (we will reconsider next year), also need to add 15U and 18U.

Toni will email the letter and form to us board members.

Assistant Coaches/Manager approvals- 11UAA- Dave Myers, Conrad Funk, and Jaclyn Jacobson as manager.

11UAAA- Chance Kantrud, Chad Kozun, Tyler Spier, and Larissa Gader as manager.

All coaches need to have an active Safe Places. If it is expired or not able to get, then the coaches are not allowed on the field until they get a CRC/VSC. They can be on the field with an approved CRC/VSC. The coaches are approved on the condition that a satisfactory Criminal Record check is provided, and/or Safe Places.

Diamond Maintenance-

Shed is priced out by the Simmie Hutterites. A 10'x12' shed is \$3360.00, to tin it is another \$2520.00, and a 8'roll-up door is another \$800.00. There is a delivery fee of \$1/km with the first 50km free.

All Maintenance needs to go through our maintenance coordinator (Butter).The City wants it streamlined and only 1 person to contact.

There is a plan for the rough fields to start fixing them in the Fall. We do need a better plan for now as the fields are in terrible shape.

If each division head could write a list with their big concerns and give the list to Butter.

We would also like to see a spraying schedule.

Need approval before going on the diamonds from Butter.

Butter would like to have a meeting or talk with 1 or 2 people from each team that will be their main field maintenance person. We had about \$1600 worth of damage on the new tractors so they need to know the rules- ex- no driving off the curbs, and turn the key off when done.

Cages- Post came today. Cages will be marked under constructions. Garnett will be starting on Friday with his crew.

There are 2 new L screens, and 3 pails of balls that are to be used only in the batting cages. No other balls should be used in the batting cages.

There is a new net in the garage. Every year we will take down the net.
