The following is required of volunteers working with children in Saskatchewan.

- The "Respect in Sport" course is MANDATORY for all coaches/volunteers in any sport
 or activity in Saskatchewan. RiS is valid for 5 years. This online course can be found at
 www.sasksport.sk.ca/RiS (link is also under COACHES tab on our website)
- A current Criminal Record Check (with Vulnerable Sector Check) please take the
 record check letter found under the COACHES tab on the website to your local RCMP
 detachment CRCs are valid for 2 years. They can be dropped off at the SCSA office.
 Please contact NATALIE at swiftcurrentsoccer@gmail.com if you are unsure of your CRC
 date.
- If you are already "youth certified" through **SAFE PLACES** with the City of Swift Current, we will require a photocopy of your card.
- Online Registration with SCSA After completion of these items, register as Team
 Personnel HERE You are required to enter your RiS# and date of CRC on the
 registration form.
 - ***SASK SOCCER ASSOCIATION states that coaches cannot be on the pitch until they are registered and have provided the Criminal Record Check.***

GENERAL INFORMATION:

COACH MEETINGS: At SCSA office (885 6th Avenue NE)

April 15: U5 – 6:00 **April 16:** U11 – 6:00 U7 – 7:00 U13 – 7:30

U9 - 8:00

U9-U13 teams will be selected at the meetings (some may be done by regular coaches who know the players ahead of the meetings) . U5-U7 teams will be made up by coordinator ahead of time.

TEAMS: Send an email or phone your players by **APRIL 25** with the following info:

- Coach contact information
- Date, time, place for first day
- All players need to wear shin pads with socks over top. No jewellery, hats, or sunglasses
- Anything else you would like your players to know.

<u>T-SHIRTS:</u> U5-U7 receive Tim Hortons soccer kits. The players will receive t-shirts to keep. Please leave any leftover shirts in the bag in the SCSA shed.

<u>WEATHER:</u> Really, the only weather that cancels a soccer game, is thunder & lightning. If the coaches decide that the weather is too cold, etc. for the kids in younger age groups – they can decide between them to cancel the game. *If you do have to cancel a game for whatever reason (U9 & older) please email <u>scsareferees@gmail.com</u> so that the referee can be notified. If the weather is bad enough that SCSA cancels soccer – it will be sent out by email thru our system and posted on Swift Current Online, twitter, facebook, radio, etc.

The full weather policy including lightning is HERE (under OUTDOOR SEASON on the website)*

<u>GAME SCORES (U11 and older):</u> Standings are kept in U11 and older. Home team provides the game sheet. Referees will keep game sheets and hand them in to SCSA office. <u>PLEASE be sure that the date, division, and team names are clearly stated on the game sheet.</u>

EQUIPMENT: Balls, flags, and a pump will be kept at each field and each team will be given a key to the equipment locker. **KEYS** can be left in the locker for SCSA to pick up at the end of the season.

<u>ASHLEY PARK</u>: **U9 teams**, please put the flags & balls out. **U11 teams**, put equipment away. <u>PERRY FIELD</u>: **U13 home team** put the flags & balls out. **U13 away team**, put equipment away.

Please make sure the last person at the locker secures the lock.
