The league plays according to the <u>IFAB Laws of the Game</u> and the modified laws of the games as found in:

Sunny South Soccer Rules & Regulations.

Hereafter the following abbreviations will be used: Taber & District Soccer Association – TDSA.
Sunny South District Soccer Association – SSDSA.
Alberta Soccer Association – ASA.

Please find below a summary of the modifications. If it is not included in the modifications list below, please refer to the SSDSA Rules & Regulations or IFAB Laws of the Game.

- Size 5 balls (standard).
- Playing time: All players that participate regularly and put into the team an honest effort are expected to get equal play time, playing at least 50% of the game.
- Referees <u>must</u> be treated with respect and as the only and final authority before, during and after the game. They are never to be yelled at or questioned negatively. They may be approached at half time or at the end of the game in a respectful, calm, upbuilding manner. Their say is final. If you have concerns, please don't hesitate to let the TDSA official co-ordinator or the age category director know.
