None opposed.</li> <li>By next September no longer WRRA. Regions are joining to form one league (not much will change – same zones/districts) will offer more consistency</li> <li>New team has been formed.</li> <li>Webmaster:</li> <li>TRA website showing an "insecure" message. Jason has addressed this.</li> <li>Breakout Goaltending clinic well received on Dec 30<sup>th</sup>. 13 goalies in attendance. Great feedback. Considering another in February.</li> <li>Powerskating: next session begins next week. Based on feedback and request from Mike we will not be combining groups. Current registrations: 3 (FUN2/3) and 11 (U12). Please promote. Jason will send an email to U12's. Made the decision to cancel FUN2/3 based on registration.</li> <li>Player Development Funds \$200/team goalies and \$300/team: coaches are going to be sent an email to review what they can do with their team funds. So far only U16's have accessed funds. Need a stand alone policy on team development funds so it's accessible to everyone. Clarified that it cannot be used for pizza/parties</li> <li>Discussed 3 on 3 league: would like to start April 14<sup>th</sup> x 6 weeks. Would like to book Fri./Sat ideally. Mon. Wed. secondary options. 30 minute games no flood. Discussed requesting 3 hours of ice on Friday night.</li> <li>Prep for Rep: 6 week clinic to prepare kids for A level play. \$100. 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		<ul> <li>Optional dust of your skates to start last two weeks of August and then break into evaluations in September.</li> <li>Preparing information for kids moving up to U12 and above to explain the team formation process before the end of this year so that we are more transparent about it but also so that parents and players know the expectations and differences between commitment, travel and cost</li> <li>Coach Development: Would like an hour off ice in a community centre room and then an hour on ice to support new coaches in August (Wednesday). Consider a second session a month or two into season to review/offer opportunity to ask question.</li> <li>Discussed TRA summer camps. Discussed paying organizers/senior counsellors out of profits. Discussed having unpaid high school students looking for volunteer hours in addition.</li> </ul>	
9.0	Equipment (Brad)	<ul> <li>8 dozen rings have been ordered – pick up Wednesday</li> <li>Ongoing concerns with access to practice rings – appears some teams are locking them in their own cages. Seems as though some teams are offering rings to players to practice at home. Discussed that players should be purchasing their own. Consider sending a message notifying coaches of the cost of each ring (\$10) and asking that all rings should be returned. Consider a second strap for practice rings. Consider selling rings on our RAMP store/pop up store.</li> <li>Jason R provides quote for travel shot clock (\$2683.75). We can borrow from region/other associations to start.
