13. Sponsorship

- Bunnies Jerseys have the iron-on logo applied and completed at no cost (used the remainder of a sponsor from last year)
- We ended up with 2 sponsors per team (besides the u16, they requested and paid additional for their additional sponsor bars). Some new sponsors who are likely to continue.
- All new Sponsor Bars have been distributed to teams.
- Discussed how to manage sponsor bars. Some reportedly were not returned at the end of last season. Discussed possible fee to the team. Decided to have teams return unused bars promptly at the beginning of the season to avoid unused bars ending up lost/behind cages/in jersey bags. Decided not to instill a fee at this time.

14. Tournament & Major Events

- Registration closes on Oct 19 but we don't anticipate any additions at this point. We did not get enough registrations to run U16, U14B or U12A.
- Draft schedule has been created. Games will be starting at 1pm on Friday. All games will be done by 5pm on Sunday.
- There are a few hours of ice proposed to be returned, discussed keeping it for practices.
- Service Master will be sponsoring the tournament medals. Medals will be ordered tomorrow. Confirm order for FUN1 (50- to be paid by TRA)
- discussed \$400 prize for 1st place in 18+C rather than medals
- We will be allowed to sell food in the Lion's Den
- Budget looks good - expecting to turn a small profit overall.
- Last year's U12A were given \$350 for team volunteer efforts. The budget could accommodate extending the same offer to our U16, U14B and U12A teams this year if they volunteer - all of

these teams would have participated in our tournament if there had been enough registrants. Motion passed to offer \$200 per team towards another tournament.

16. Learn to Skate & Adult League

Learn to skate:

- Discussed recruiting for this position and importance of that board member being available and at the arena during the bunny ice time for ease of communication and to support the program.

We are going to start the first week at \$10 dollars and see how many people we can get to come out. You can either bring cash or etransfer on the date.

This is an all levels drop in meaning even if your new to the game or don't know it at all we want you to come out and have some fun. A stick, skates and helmet are mandatory but we do recommend wearing whatever makes you feel comfortable on the ice.

We will require a release form to be signed prior to joining on the ice.
