



# TOFIELD MINOR HOCKEY

## VISITING TEAM GAME CHECKLIST

The following considerations provide a checklist for a host team/ association to communicate relevant information to the teams, spectators and timekeepers prior to any games. It is important that the host communicates with its facility so that any specific guidelines/ regulations in place for that facility are shared with visiting team(s).

**SPECTATORS-** Only 2 spectators per visiting participant allowed. Due to the restriction of indoor crowds, as per AHS, we are only allowed a maximum 100 spectators in the arena. If we reach the 100 mark, anyone else will be turned away at the door. Please enter through the same door as your players. The lobby door will be locked.

**MASKING REQUIRMENTS-** Masks are required in all areas of the arena. Players may remove their masks once they are in their dressing rooms with helmets on.

**ENTRY AND EXIT PROCESS-** Visiting teams will be notified if they will in dressing room(s) 1, 2, 3, 4 or the hallway, before your scheduled game. Please enter and exit through the door labeled "Players Entrance" on the SOUTH side of the building. All spectators will enter and exit through the same door as the player. Please note that our lobby is closed, door will remain locked.

**TIME RESTRICTIONS-** Players will enter no earlier than 15 minutes before game time and leave no later than 15 minutes after game time. Please note, there are no exceptions at this time.

**DRESSING ROOMS-** Dressing rooms have a maximum number of participants allowed. TMHA will contact the team before access and let you know how many kids per room and if needed, hallway. All rooms are marked with arrows, to where the child will sit. There is no shower access at this time. ONE parent per child is allowed in the dressing room, masked, if they need to help tie skates, put on helmet. Once they are done, they may exit the dressing room as soon as possible.

**WARM UP/ COOL DOWN SPACE-** At this time there is no availability for warm ups or cool downs inside the arena.

**WATER BOTTLES-** Please come with your water bottle filled, to lessen the foot traffic in and out of the bathrooms.

**PLAYERS AND TEAM OFFICIALS FACILITY ACCESS-** Players may enter and exit through the assigned doors, along with Team officials and spectators. Please do not linger in the hallways, siblings are to be seated with their parents at all times during the game. There is no wandering through the arena at this time. Please note that the lobby is closed, but the bathrooms are accessible. Spectators will enter and exit through the same doors as the players.

**SKATE SHARPENING-** There is no skate sharpening available at this time.

**EMERGENCY ACCESS PLAN-** If there is an emergency and all participants, spectators and officials have to exit the building, please exit through the closest door, players first, then coaches and spectators.

**PARKING-** If you are in dressing rooms 1-4, there is plenty of parking on the south side of the building (the front). If you are in dressing rooms 5 and 6, you may park in the south parking lot, or there is another parking lot on the North side of the building with closer access to the East entrance.

**LIVE STREAMING-** There is no live streaming at this time.

## GENERAL FACILITY RESTRICTIONS-

- 2 Spectators max per visiting player (including siblings).
- Please wear a mask at all times while in the arena.
- All players and spectators from the same team will enter and exit through the assigned players' doors.
- There is no wandering the arena, please stay out of dressing rooms that are not assigned to you, due to sanitization.
- Please have your family sit within the black lines on the bench, with an empty spot in front of, behind and to each side of you. Each line represents approximately 6', the recommended distance as per AHS and Hockey Alberta.
- Please note that siblings will remain with their families at all times.
- The lobby is closed at this time and only accessible for washroom use.
- Concession is closed.
- Once the game is complete, please exit the arena immediately and wait for your player outside, unless you have to assist them with their skates and helmet, then one family member may enter the dressing room. If you have a sibling attending and need to tie skates, please have your child sit on the bench available in the hallway.
- Players can arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before their game and leave no later than 15 minutes after their game.
