Such rules outline the Tri-County Basketball Association policy in such areas as registration, refunds, administration of programs, playing rules, and by-laws and regulations. I hereby give my consent for any player's picture or name to be used in any Tri-County Basketball Association publications necessary. I will remain responsible for the player during, to and from all Tri-County Basketball Association activities and I agree that the Tri-County Basketball Association team/game officials shall in no event be held liable or accused of negligence or any other charges. I hereby agree to hold harmless Tri-County Basketball Association, team and game officials from any claim or lawsuit. I understand that completion and submission of this application and receipt by Tri-County Basketball Association will bind the above named individual to Tri-County Basketball Association for the entire basketball event(s) for which I am registering.

Privacy Policy

Privacy of Personal & Personal Health Information

Tri-County Basketball Association understands the importance of its members' privacy and the sensitivity of personal information. Tri-County Basketball Association is committed to protecting privacy in its collection, use, and distribution of personal information. This Policy outlines how Tri-County Basketball Association manages its members' personal and personal health information and safeguards privacy.

What is Personal Information?

Personal information is information about an identifiable individual such as name, age, ethnic origin, home addresses, personal email addresses, and home telephone numbers. Personal information does not include the work title, business address or business telephone number of an employee. This exception has been referred to as "business card" or "non-personal" information. Tri-County Basketball Association uses both personal and non-personal information when providing services to its members.

What is Personal Health Information?

Personal Health Information is any recorded information about an identifiable individual related to that person's health or health care history, the provision of health care to the individual or payment for health care provided to that individual.

Collecting Personal & Personal Health Information

Tri-County Basketball Association collects and uses personal and personal health information to be able to provide its members with services as well as to develop and enhance its service to its members. For example, Tri-County Basketball Association collects, uses, and discloses personal

information to:

- create a mailing list for distribution of Tri-County Basketball Association materials;
- communicate with members about activities of Tri-County Basketball Association;
- maintain membership information;
- administer insurance and/or benefit plans;
- investigate, process, and arbitrate grievances;
- create Tri-County Basketball Association statistics;
- promote the sport of basketball.

Tri-County Basketball Association collects personal and personal health information about members in a variety of ways including the following:

- Voluntarily from members
- Registration forms
- Information provided by other sporting and/or basketball organizations, including the National Sport Organization (NSO)

Consent

When members complete an application for benefits under an insurance plan administered by Tri-County Basketball Association or sign any Tri-County Basketball Association form, members consent to the use of their personal and personal health information by Tri-County Basketball Association for the purposes listed above and to the sharing of personal and personal health information with third parties by Tri-County Basketball Association.

Disclosure of Personal & Personal Health Information

Under certain circumstances, Tri-County Basketball Association will disclose its members' personal and personal health information:

When members have consented to the disclosure; or

If the disclosure is required to comply with a subpoena or warrant issued or an order made by a court, person or body with jurisdiction to compel the production of information, or to comply with rules of court relating to the production of records; or

When the services that Tri-County Basketball Association is providing requires it to give information to third parties (for example, administrators of insurance or benefit plans), members' consent will be implied, unless members tell us otherwise.;

or

Where there exists or it is believed that there exists an imminent and serious risk to the physical or mental health of a member.

Third Party Access

Tri-County Basketball Association has agreements with other parties that, when they receive personal and personal health information from Tri-County Basketball Association, the personal and personal health information will be safeguarded and protected from unauthorized use or unintended use. Tri-County Basketball Association does not disclose personal and personal health information to any third party to enable them to market their products and services. Tri-County Basketball Association does not sell member lists to third parties.

Limits on the Use and Retention of Personal & Personal Health Information

Tri-County Basketball Association will not disclose sensitive information for a new purpose beyond that to which members have consented. Members may withdraw consent at any time upon reasonable notice, subject to legal or contractual restrictions.

Personal and personal health information is retained by Tri-County Basketball Association for a period that is reasonable to fulfill the purpose for which the information was collected. Once this reasonable period has expired the Society destroys the personal and personal health information using appropriate methods.

Destruction of Personal & Personal Health Information

Tri-County Basketball Association shall take care when storing or destroying its members' personal and personal health information in order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure.

Security of Information

Tri-County Basketball Association takes all reasonable precautions to ensure that personal and personal health information is kept safe from loss, unauthorized access, modification or disclosure. Among the steps taken to protect information are:

Premises security;

Storing of files in cabinets or offices that are not accessible to members;
Technological safeguards like computer passwords, security software, and firewalls to prevent hacking or unauthorized computer access.

Breaches of Security of Information

Any and all breaches of the security of the personal and personal health information received by Tri-County Basketball Association are to be immediately reported to the Executive Director and are to be communicated to the Board of Tri-County Basketball Association at the first available Board meeting following the incident in question. The Board will take whatever action it deems appropriate with respect to the breach of security of information.

Updating Personal & Personal Health Information

Since Tri-County Basketball Association uses its members' personal and personal health information to provide services to members, it is important that the information be accurate and up-to-date. If any information changes, members are asked to inform Tri-County Basketball Association so that the necessary changes can be made. Tri-County Basketball Association will take reasonable steps to correct any information that is not accurate, complete or up-to-date.

Changes to this Policy

Since Tri-County Basketball Association regularly reviews all of its policies and procedures, Tri-County Basketball Association may change this Privacy Policy from time to time.

Refund Policy

TCBA understands and appreciates that sometimes registrants will be required to remove themselves from basketball for reasons beyond their control. TCBA is also a non-profit organization that operates under a very tight budget with very little money to spare .

TCBA will honor partial refunds of registration fees up until the time that teams are set, insurance fees are paid, and league fees are paid. After these fees are paid TCBA reserves the right to decide to issue or not issue partial refunds to registrants. They will be decided on an individual basis and without prejudice.
