2021/2022 Registration

On behalf of the Port Hardy Minor Hockey Executive, we are so excited to welcome you to the 2021/2022 minor hockey season!

Please find attached the 2021/2022 TriPort Minor Hockey Registration Form. Registration is on a first come-first served basis until teams are filled. If a full team cannot be declared, some age divisions may be combined to ensure all players have an opportunity to participate in the season.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

July 25 – August 22, 2021 – Registration period for the 2021/2022 season. Registration after August 22nd are not guaranteed team placement. Please note that all forms must be completed, and a minimum insurance fee of \$60.00 paid prior to your player participating on the ice.

October 1, 2021 – All players must have at least one parent/guardian successfully complete the Parent Respect in Sport course by this date. This is a BC Hockey MANDATORY requirement. This course must be renewed every 5 years. If you are unsure if your RIS certification is current, we can advise you upon request. The best time to complete this is <u>before</u> the season starts! PLAYER FORMS

Once the seasons begins, your player will receive the required player forms: medical form, player's contract, parent contract, and Covid-19 guidelines. These must be completed prior to league start.

REGISTRATION FEES

Payment can be made by etransfer to **porthardyminorhockey@gmail.com** with player first and last name and division in the memo. Cheques can be made payable to **Port Hardy Minor Hockey Association** with player first and last name and division on the memo line.

Fees are due upon registration. Port Hardy Minor Hockey accepts registration fees to be paid on a payment plan with a signed payment agreement. Insurance fees of \$60.00 must be paid upon

registration. Payment due dates are: October 15, November 15, December 15. Players with any outstanding fees after December 15 will be ineligible to return to the ice until all outstanding fees are paid in full. Parents are responsible for submitting their own KidSport subsidy forms.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS

Running a well-organized hockey association requires the help of everyone! Parent volunteers are required as managers, and safety persons. Parent help is also required for game clock, game sheets, music, skate tying, fundraising and any related Covid-19 health & safety guidelines. As we welcome you back to the rink to cheer on your player, we also need your help in and around the rink to make this season happen. Many hands make light work.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

We will be welcoming everyone back to the arena for normal game play under viaSport Covid-19 Step 4 guidelines by September 7, 2021. Please follow any and all guidelines related to the health and safety of our players and the arenas we play in. Please note that these guidelines may change according to viaSport and/or any changing Public Health Orders. Any changes will be clearly communicated by the Association.

COMMUNICATION

Your executive is committed to clear and respectful communication. The best place for Association updates is on our Facebook page. Please join our page under Port Hardy Minor Hockey Club. Each team may use TeamSnap or Facebook for individual team communication throughout the season. Respectful social media etiquette is expected at all times.

Throughout the season, if you have a difficulty you need to resolve, PHMHA follows TriPort and BC Hockey guidelines for conflict resolution. This includes following the 24-hour rule. Please contact your team manager to resolve any conflict directly. Your manager will discuss any issues with coaching staff, and any meeting between parents and team officials will wait 24-hours to ensure all parties are calm while resolving issues. Difficulties that cannot be resolved at the team manager/coach level will be moved to the Port Hardy Executive for resolution. Respectful communication at all levels is required at all times. Parents and players are expected to represent the Port Hardy Minor Hockey Association both in and around the arena with the utmost respect and leadership. Abuse of on-ice and off-ice officials will not be tolerated.
