


CLINIC REGISTRATION HOW-TO 2023

1. Follow the link [HERE](#) to register for a VSA Clinic (Same link for referee and coach clinics). It will take you to the site pictured below. Login with your email and your normal RAMP password. This will be the same as if you were registering for your home club.

3. Select the "Clinic Registration". The page below should show up. You can use the drop-down arrows to select what type of clinic you are looking to register for. Our VSA Clinics will show up here, as well as any that are updated by the SSA. Select the clinic that you would like to register for and follow the steps from there to complete registration. **For referees, a second course will need to be added, follow steps 4-6.** For Coaches, you will need to complete online courses through Canada Soccer. For these you will need codes purchased by our Technical Staff. Please contact Cam at technical.director@valleysoccer.ca to inquire about coach codes. 



4. Referees will need to register for the online portion of their clinic through their home club portal. This is also where you will register to be a ref for your town association. You can find the town registration links on our [website](#) under "Towns/Clubs". For this example, I will use Dalmeny Minor Soccer. Login with your personal RAMP account as always. Once logged in, you will see the same options as before. Select clinic registration and then the following options should show up.

Thank you for registering to the Canada Soccer Entry Level Referee Course. Sign in to Google Classroom (<https://classroom.google.com/>) using the same email address you signed up for the course (or potentially create a google account attached to your email). Once you are logged in, click the + symbol > Join a Class > Enter the Class Code [REDACTED]

Individuals should ensure they have their full name (accurate) for the Google Classroom so the name they have registered under and the name that shows up on the classroom are the same. Individuals also must make sure that the proper google account is logged in when completing the Online Theory.

You must complete all the coursework before registering for an in-person on-field workshop. To register for the in-person (classroom and on-field) workshop, you will need to contact your Member Organization.
