President's Report:

Sean gave a season summary; 5 communities came to play in town, 16 teams, hosted team tournaments, U11 playoffs, and U13 provincials.

Registration fees stay low - fundraising. Expect ice fees to continue to increase (haven't seen in 2 years). Ref fees will go up (we pay for courses, and we have 4 man refs at U11 and up)

Development allowance was lower than the budget. Next year association wide development instead of team level, with levels getting smaller amounts

This year's jersey sponsorship money went into GICs again.

Both male and female U11 teams hosted finals in Vermilion. All attending teams have paid us for their portion of the ref/ice costs. U13F Provincials were also hosted here and it was a big success thanks to the help of the numerous families and the community. VMH profited \$11,426.76 from it.

Cash flow is better this year. Major increase in tournament revenue. Switching to a POS system definitely contributed to this increase. VMHA golf tournament brought in around \$7700 of additional revenue this year.

Registrations for the 25/26 season was \$153,144. Ice fees and referee fees were up this year. Ice fees were \$154,143 and ref fees were \$58,000.

\$1,940 in goalie development was reimbursed to returning VMH goalies as per the handbook.

Of the \$11,000 allocated for individual team development sessions, only \$6327 was utilized.

VP Business Report:

Most sponsors came back. New KWS Seeds and Iron Works. Golf tournament for 2026; 72 golfer cap this year, date is June 19th 2026. Summer Chris will work on securing sponsors for next year

VP Development Report:

Coach/VMHA feedback will go out after the gala. Development money was not utilized, next year most of it will go into power skating 5 sessions/team with Chad Cabana, age groups tbd. Goalie development was good.

Registrar's Report:

Rob 2025/2026 season report; 245 players, 24 outside association, 1/3 are female players.
