The Tournament Planning and Procedures Manual were created for VMHA Tournament Coordinators, to simplify tournament planning and management of all tournaments. The information presented here is intended to guide volunteers; however, the individual requirements of each tournament will determine what additional or different procedures are needed.

The objective of this manual is to facilitate a consistent and repeatable planning process for all VMHA tournaments. All stages of tournament planning and management are outlined, from early planning, through implementation, tournament wrap-up and review.

The manual is a valuable guide for both new and returning volunteers. Without volunteers, there would be no tournaments. The goal is to provide our volunteers with the tools, support, and guidance they need to create a fantastic event that we can all take pride in. Tournaments that are well-planned and executed are fun for everyone – the players, coaches, parents and volunteers.

This manual is a work in progress. Please continue to use and review it and submit any suggestions for additions or enhancements to the active VMHA.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR

The [Tournament Director](#) is a member appointed by the VMHA Executive and is responsible for the overall coordination of all VMHA tournaments and related activities. The Tournament Director reports directly to the [VMHA Treasurer](#).

Responsibilities

- Consult with divisional coordinator(s)
- Ensure tournament coordinators submit a post-tournament financial statement.
- Balance post-tournament financials to AGLC license(s) and cash received.
- Deposit cash from tournament(s).
- Balance post-tournament Income/Expenses to receipts
- Calculate 50/50 earnings to be given to each team
- Provide \$1,000.00 Raffle table contract to tournament coordinator(s).
- Provide tournament coordinator with cashbox and key(s).
- Prepares and maintains a tournament planning manual (this document)
- Provide an estimated budget
- Provide tournament fees for each division.
- Provide receipts for any donations made to tournaments.
- Meet with [AGLC Coordinator](#) to go over post-tournament License requirements
- Provide Treasurer with copy of deposit and income/expenses for each team
- Track each tournament and report to VMHA board.

TOURNAMENT COORDINATOR(S)

The Tournament Coordinator(s) is responsible for the over planning and coordination of the designated tournament. The Tournament Coordinator(s) reports directly to the VMHA Tournament Director. Each team is responsible for assigning 2 volunteers to be tournament coordinator(s) when one (1) team is hosting. Where multiple teams are hosting – one (1) tournament coordinator from each team.

Responsibilities

- Monitor the Planning Timelines to ensure key milestones are being achieved.
- Establish meeting times and places for planning sessions
- Plan/shop for:
 - o Raffle table items Locally (keep all receipts).
 - o Player swag, MVP, heart & hustle, coach gifts, etc.
 - o Tournament prizes (e.g. Trophies, medals or money – money will be given by cheque only) ****NO MONEY IS TO BE TAKEN OR GIVEN FROM CASHBOX****
- Plan and obtain licenses needed for tournament(s) (i.e. Lotto, liquor, 50/50, large & small items) from [AGLC Coordinator](#).
- Team families may be requested to donate no more than \$25.00 or 1 bottle of liquor.
- Work with Coaches, Managers and members to choose teams
- Communicate with interested and registered teams as required
- Maintains a record of registered teams
- Prepares team rosters for the tournament program.



- Prepares team contact list for the tournament including cellphone numbers and emails. Keep that contact list with you at the tournament with all cell phone numbers in case of game or arena change.
- Sends out game schedules to registered teams
- Develop tournament game schedule once given ice times by VMHA
- VMHA will provide you with the game times and arenas for your tournament. You may use a template from previous years' tournament to get you started.
- Friday night: when scheduling the teams for Friday night be mindful of the teams with the longest distance to travel and schedule them later in the evening. The exception is if a team from out of town is here the evening before (ie: arrives Thursday night for tournament that begins Friday).
- Saturday Morning: Ideally, two travelling teams who would be staying in a hotel would have the first game Saturday morning since they are arguably the closest to the rink. Try to avoid scheduling a visiting team with a long commute for the first game. Also, do not schedule the teams who played the latest game on Friday night for the first game on Saturday morning.
- When teams have two games in one day, try to give them a minimum of two hours of rest between the end of their first game and the start of their second game.
- Since there is a small advantage (last ice change) in being the home team, vary this privilege between the VMHA team(s) and their guests. It is a small thing but attention to detail is important!
- Send the game schedule and tournament rules to [Referee in Chief \(RIC\)](#) (Ref Coordinator) to ensure tournament rules are posted in the referee's room during the tournament. Ensure you have the RIC's phone number if you need to contact them during the tournament.
- Schedule timeclock, boards, raffle table and 50/50 shifts. ****All parents must help****
- Assemble information to assist the volunteers to do their jobs efficiently during the tournament.
- Coordinate tournament set-up, tear-down and on-site supervision during the tournament.
- Manages all prize draws.
- Conduct a post-tournament meeting with volunteers to tie up all loose ends. Discuss what worked, what did not work well and how tournament can be improved for the following year.
- Provide [Tournament Director](#) with tournament financial statement, AGLC license(s) and money from tournament as quickly as possible.
- Return cashbox and key(s) to [Tournament Director](#).

Tournament Packages

- Welcome/coaches' packages for the teams should include:
 - o Rules
 - o Schedule
 - o Copy of Coach/Player conduct
 - o Tournament team standing sheet
 - o Shoot Out rules (if your tournament is doing a Shoot Out)
 - o Things to Do while in Vermilion and area
 - o Map page
 - o Collect any coupons being donated to be put in the coaches' welcome package so they can distribute to their players.
 - o MVP list for each team and Heart & Hustle Award list as well.
 - Coaches will name their own Heart & Hustle and either the opposing Coach or Team's head coach will name the MVP.
 - o Email teams welcoming them to your tournament
 - o Provide information (e.g. accommodation, where information can be found on VMHA website)
 - o Inform the teams of your Program Draw and awesome raffle table. Also advise them if you are doing any special raffle prizes.
 - o Make sure you have an extra set of jerseys for the tournament if you need to use them for conflict in jersey colour.
 - o Interpret and enforce tournament rules.
 - o Collect game sheets and update the score board after each game – upload all game sheets to Hockey Alberta with the required information.
 - o Deliver coach packages to the proper arena for their first game of the tournament.
 - o Have a contact for the teams be available by cell phone to assist throughout the tournament. (post contact name and number at i.e. Raffle Table)
- Sample Ice Schedule and Scoreboard
 - o Ice times will be provided by VMHA Ice Scheduler
 - o Any changes to ice times should involve the manager of another team, and the Ice Scheduler.

the selection process is an important part of hosting a tournament. When hosting, having competitive teams; makes for a more enjoyable experience overall, for everyone involved.

When it comes to team selection, coaches will typically have a good idea how the compatibility may be, and teams can invite those teams accordingly.

A 'top' team from the Division below, or the 'bottom' team from the division above, could also poentially compete with teams in your tournament.

Your Head Coach MUST be included when determining the teams that will be invited to your tournament.

Some thoughts to consider:

- o How many of the players are 1st or 2nd year, in comparison to other teams in the tournament?
- o How many skaters & goalies are on the team?
- o Ask the team if they played in any other tournaments and how they ranked?
- o Have any of the teams played exhibition games outside their area and how did they do?

Official team Rosters

Teams must provide (have on hand), a copy of their Official Team Roster.

Note: this is NOT the score sheet or sticker labels. The Official Team Roster comes from Hockey Canada, via Registrar. This is a sample, for reference:

Tournament Programs

If using an outside printer, it is recommended to confirm the timelines and a quote from the printing company, to ensure the printer can meet the deadlines and the pricing is reasonable.

Games Sheets

All game information must be recorded, and game sheets provided to the host team tournament coordinator or host team website coordinator for entering to Hockey Alberta within 24 hours. Any suspensions MUST also be reported.

It is recommended to fill out each game sheet in advance and have them ready to go at your "information/welcome table"

Tournament Cancellation Policy

A place may be held for a maximum of 2 weeks before receiving an entry fee. 25% of the entry fee is non-refundable. If a team cancels out of a tournament after paying their fee, their fee (minus the 25%) will be refunded only if their position in the tournament can be filled. In special circumstances, teams may appeal to the Vermilion Minor Hockey Executive to have all or a portion of their fees returned.

Tournament Rules

1. **Rules:** CAHA and HA rules and regulations apply.
2. **Length of Games:** All games will consist of three 20 minute stop time periods. If the game is running late; OR if there is a 6 or more goal lead in the last 10 minutes, the time keeper will alert the referee that the game will be shortened and the clock will be running straight time until the time allotment is up; OR there is less than a 6 goal lead.
3. **Penalties:**
 - i. Minor: 2 minute stop time - 3 minute straight time
 - ii. Major: 5 minute stop time - 8 minute straight time
4. **Round Robin Ties:** A tie will remain a tie during the Round Robin competition. The total points obtained in Round Robin competition (2 Points for a win, 1 point for tie, 0 points for a loss) with the goal differential being capped at 10 per game) will determine the higher placing team.
In the event teams are tied for play-off positions the following procedure will apply in the order presented:
 - I. If two teams are tied, and they have played each other in the Round Robin competition, the winner of the game between the two teams will be awarded the higher position.
If teams are still tied at the end of the Round Robin, the team with the best goal average will qualify. The goal average of a team is to be determined by dividing the total number of GOALS FOR and AGAINST in to the TOTAL number of GOALS with the team having the HIGHEST PERCENTAGE WINNING the HIGHER POSITION.
 - II. If still tied, team with the least amount of penalty minutes will be declared the winner
 - III. If still tied, coin toss
5. **SUNDAY FINAL GAME** if tied after regulation time,
 - I. 5 minute 3 on 3 sudden death overtime will take place.
 - II. If still tied, there will be a 3 player shoot out.
 - III. If still tied, a sudden death shoot-out with different shooters each time. Each player must shoot once before a player can go again.
6. All teams must submit their player roster to scorekeepers 15 or more minutes before the schedule game start time.
7. Any player who receives a match penalty (ie. Intent to injure) will be suspended for the duration of the tournament.
8. Any team official who receives a misconduct or gross misconduct penalty will be suspended and his team given a minor penalty, to be served by a player on the ice at the time of the penalty.
Managers and coaches shall be deemed responsible for the behavior of their teams and team's supporters. Teams or members may be suspended from the tournament for misbehavior on or off the ice, at the discretion of the tournament discipline committee. There will be zero tolerance for abuse of the ice officials. Any disputes will be decided by the Tournament Committee and decisions will be final.
