ATTENDANCE

As a Premier player you will be expected to:

1. attend all practices and games in the Spring season
2. arrive at each session at the time specified by the coach
3. provide a valid reason to the coaching staff if you are to be late or absent from any session
4. Be available for July Provincials for U13 to U18 teams.

CONFLICTS

As a Premier player during the Vernon United Spring soccer season you are expected to fulfill your obligations to your team.

CONDUCT

As a Premier player representing the North Okanagan Youth Soccer Association you will be expected to:

1. respect all others including teammates, opponents, coaches and officials at all NOYSA events
2. refrain from any verbal or physical abuse [All abuse is unacceptable and will be dealt with forthwith]

Players failing to comply with the above may be excluded from games or training sessions and if deemed serious enough there may be disciplinary action taken with ultimately a dismissal from the program.

GENERAL

- Team training will be offered in the indoor in the winter. This training is optional but players are expected to attend as many sessions as possible.
