



## **VERNON UNITED COACH ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES**

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**OBJECTIVES:** To create a passion for competitive soccer for life through a patient, positive and encouraging fashion. Improve the players technical game of soccer and knowledge of the game.

**OVERVIEW/TIME COMMITMENT:** The Vernon United Rep Program is a 10-month program.

- Volunteer/parent coaches are assigned to teams U11-U18
- October-March: 1 indoor session per week alongside NOYSA TD Dave Broadhurst
- April – end of June Practices Tuesday/Thursday 5pm-6:30pm
- Games are almost always on Sundays in Vernon, Kelowna, Kamloops, Penticton, Salmon Arm or Revelstoke.
- Resources for practice plans are available through NOYSA
- Coaching clinics are facilitated for VU coaches by Dave Broadhurst
- Teams are encouraged to enter 2 tournaments.
- Ice Breaker Tournament Easter Weekend (Or another tournament of choice)
- Slurpee Cup May Long Weekend (or another tournament of choice)
- Coaches will pick up team equipment at the beginning of the season and drop it off at the end of the season.
- Coaches will receive Adidas Coach apparel.
- Teams have team managers to help with team communications and schedules, tournament registrations etc.
- Team/Individual photos will take place the weekend of May 3<sup>rd</sup>

### **CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- **All NOYSA coaches are required to do a CRC. NOYSA will cover the cost and send you the link.**
- All Vernon United Coaches must complete the Respect in Sport Activity Leader Certification. (2hr online certification)
- It is preferred if coaches have age-appropriate coaching courses. NOYSA covers the cost of coaching courses.
