ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- *ALL on-ice officials (coaches, asst coaches, & trainers) must complete Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders.
- *U7 & U9 1 Coach per 10 players is required to complete "COACH 1" courses. Also, 1 Coach per 10 players is required to complete "SAFETY" courses.
- *U11 U18 All Head coaches must complete the "COACH 2" courses and the "CHECKING SKILLS" courses. One team official must complete the "SAFETY" courses.
- *It is highly recommended (but not mandatory) that Assistant Coaches take the above-mentioned Coach, Safety, & Checking Skills courses as well.
- *Any coach/trainer that successfully completes all of the required courses for their position is eligible to be reimbursed by VMHA if receipts are submitted to the Treasurer within the year in which they were completed.

COACH SELECTION PROCESS:

- *Any individual interested in coaching for VMHA shall indicate their intentions at the time when Player Registration opens prior to each new season. All applications must be resubmitted annually.

Important instructions for the person requesting the Criminal Records Check:

- 1. You must apply in person to your local RCMP Detachment.
- 2. Bring two pieces of ID (one must be a driver's license).
- 3. To accept the completed form, you must appear in person to pick it up.
- 4. After you apply for the CRC, there is a possibility that you will need to return in person for fingerprints. This may add an approximate six week delay to the application.
- 5. You must submit the completed and certified CRC to the Coaching Coordinator.
