



# National Championship League: Registration Information 2024-2025

Please see important National Championship League (NCL) information below, including:

- Registration fees and deadlines for the 16U, 18U, and Senior categories as they apply to the 2024-2025 NCL season.
- Competition categories and age requirements
- A draft calendar containing the significant weekends of the 2024-2025 NCL season

## 2024-2025 Registration Process

Registration for the NCL must be completed through Water Polo Canada's (WPC) National Registration and Event Management database, RAMPInteractive®. Club representatives must register all clubs through their accounts using the Competitions feature in WPC's database system. For more information on how to register, click here [LINK]

All payments must be made via credit cards, and a 2.5% administration fee has been added to each team's registration fee as outlined in WPC's Administration Fee, Cancellation Fee and Refund Policy **LINK**]

Teams wishing to enter the NCL after the deposit deadline, and prior to the final registration deadline, must send a formal request to WPC's Senior Manager of Leagues and Pathways. These requests will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Teams registering after the deposit deadline will be imposed an additional administration fee up to a maximum of \$1200 at a rate of \$400 per week.

Clubs that have paid a deposit fee but choose not to pay the registration fee balance will not be refunded any portion of the deposit and will not be eligible to compete in the NCL. A club that chooses not to pay the full registration fee after paying the deposit can put 50% of the deposit towards the registration balance for one of the club's other 18U or Senior NCL teams

Teams wishing to enter the NCL after the deposit deadline, and prior to the final registration deadline, must send a formal request to WPC's Senior Manager of Leagues and Pathways. These requests will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Teams registering after the deposit deadline will be imposed an additional administration fee up to a maximum of \$750 at a rate of \$250 per week.

#### Senior Deposits are non-refundable

#### Tier 1

Tier 1 teams will compete in 3 regular-season events and 1 Eastern Conference Finals. These teams will compete in a round-robin event with placement games each weekend. The rankings from these weekends will provide seeding for the Eastern Conference event.

Each weekend's tournament will create a point system that will seed the East finals: 7 points for 1st place, 5 points for 2nd place, 3 points for 3rd place, 2 points for the 4th, 1 point for 5th place, and no points for the last place team.

Tier 1 will be reserved for the top 6 from the previous Senior NCL Eastern Standings.

#### Tier 2

Tier 2 will be split into a "Montreal and Ottawa" division and a "GTA" division. The teams will schedule the games in this tier, with Water Polo Canada supporting by organizing and assigning referees. The games can be played on weekday evenings or throughout the weekend and can be scheduled during club practice times or through other pool rental spaces.

Each team will be required to host all other teams in their division once per season and travel to each team in their division once per season. Once teams have worked to create a schedule for competition, they will submit their dates and times to WPC (Water Polo Canada), and WPC will assign officials for each game.

Game sheets will be completed using the 6-8 app. Teams will receive 3 points for a win and 1 point for a tie. The top 2 teams in each division will then qualify to compete in the Eastern Finals, for a chance to qualify for the National Finals. The top four teams from Eastern Finals will be Tier 1 for the following season.

### 16U East/16U West Invitational Registration\*

Team Fee: \$1,537.50 (\$1500 Registration Fee + \$37.50 Admin Fee) Registration and Payment Deadline: Monday, October 14th, 2024

Water Polo Canada will host two 16U events for each conference. These tournaments will be open but limited to teams in that specific conference. While recommended, teams are not required to attend either event to be eligible for their respective East or West finals. Please see the draft schedule below for more details on dates.

#### 16U East/16U West Final Registration

Team Fee: \$1,537.50 (\$1500 Registration Fee + \$37.50 Admin Fee) Registration and Payment Deadline: Thursday, March 21st, 2025

The 16U Conference Championships are open to all teams from their respective conferences. While recommended, teams are not required to participate in the open events or provincial leagues in order to qualify to participate in the Conference Finals.

#### **Competition Categories**

**16U**: 2009 – 2012 **18U**: 2007 – 2010

Senior: 2008 or earlier (Exception: Four (4) athletes born in 2009 can participate on each

Men's and Women's Senior Team)

Note: Athletes can play in multiple competition categories if they choose. No exceptional player exemptions for players born outside the listed competition brackets will be granted.
