RAMP Competition Registration Guide 2022-2023: International Teams
This guide was developed to provide international teams with information on how to register for a competition using WPC's National Registration Database and Event Management System, RAMPInterActive ${ }^{\circledR}$ (RAMP).

Step 1: Click the club's front end registration link.

Step 2: As the team registrar for an international team (i.e., A team from the United States) attending a Canadian water polo competition, you will be required to create a front-end account for RAMP by clicking the "Don't have an account? Create one Here" option solely for the purposes of registering their team(s) for the competition.

4.1. Select "2022-2023" from the "Choose a Season" dropdown list.
4.2. Select the name of the competition your team(s) will be attending from the "Choose a Competition" dropdown list.
4.3. As the team registrar for an international team (i.e., A team from the United States) attending a Canadian water polo competition, you will be required to add yourself as a contact in the system by selecting "Add New Contact" from the "Choose Contact" dropdown list. This will allow you to register, pay and add your roster without becoming Registrants of Water Polo Canada.
4.4. Select "Non Water Polo Canada Organization" from the "Club" dropdown list.
4.5. Select "Unrestricted Registration" from the "Registration Type" dropdown list.
4.6. Click Continue.
