The Canadian Water Polo Hall of Fame (CWPHOF) was formed to recognize and celebrate the achievements of athletes, officials, coaches and those who have dedicated their time and effort in building the sport of water polo within Canada.

The CWPHOF is the result of a long-term effort by David Hart, 4-time Olympian, and a group of celebrated Canadian water polo personalities in collaboration with Water Polo Canada.

The CWPHOF's first class was inducted in 2022.





### CANADIAN WATER POLO HALL OF FAME CATEGORIES

Annually the Canadian Water Polo Hall of Fame (CWPHOF) selects inductees for the following 8 categories through a nomination process (as determined by the CWPHOF Committee):

#### ATHLETE

Awarded to Athletes who have achieved outstanding personal and/or teamrelated success.

#### COACH

Awarded to Coaches who have achieved a degree of excellence as a coach on the Canadian national team as well as domestically

#### OFFICIAL

Awarded to Officials who have achieved excellence at both the national and international level of officiating.

#### TEAM

Awarded to Teams who have achieved outstanding international or national performances

#### **BUILDER**

Awarded to Individuals who have made a significant contribution to the sport of water polo within Canada.

#### CLUB

Awarded to Clubs who have achieved a degree of excellence through their results at National Championships

#### HISTORICAL FIGURE OR TEAM

Awarded to an individual or team who has accomplished an achievement that is of historical or significant nature.


#### DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI

Awarded to a National Team alumnus who has achieved excellence outside of water polo, including in their professional and personal life


