HEAD COACH POSITION FOR EITHER U15, U17 or U19

Criteria of Head Coach Applicants:

Applicants must be in good standing member of WCMBHA of BC and its associations and have coached ball hockey for a minimum of 5 years with minimum 2 years coaching level of a Western Challenge Cup, preference to Nationals and/or World tournament coaching experience. To apply for the Head Coach positions you must have completed and passed an NCCP level 1 equivalent (ice hockey rep program equivalent included) course or higher, a Speak Out (Respect in Sports) course, a minimum Basic First Aid program and have a Criminal check/Vulnerable Sector done.

You may be asked to present documentation for these courses during an interview if short listed as well as your criminal check forms. Coaches must be able available and be prepared to be away from work before, during and after July 24th to July 28th, 2019. The coaches chosen for the positions must follow all "Team BC Ball Hockey Program" guidelines, rules of conduct, procedures and schedules put forward to the head coach by the Team BC Program National Director and if not followed, the director has the right to revoke the appointed position at any point during the season and/or during the National tournament.

Head Coach will be responsible for:

- Assist with the scouting and selection of players at all tryouts
- Be available for all six tryout dates set by Team BC
- Work with National Director and appointed scouts on final selections
- Follow "Team BC Ball Hockey Program" guidelines, rules of conduct and program on player selection
