



Goalie Rebate Policy

Applicability

This policy applies to West Ottawa Ringette Association (“WORA”) teams at the **U12 level and above**. Teams at the U10 level and below are not eligible for rebates given that there is a focus on development and a requirement at those levels to rotate through the goalie position.

Policy

WORA Players in the following situations may request a goalie rebate:

Rebate 1. A full refund of WORA registration fees (excludes Ringette Ontario fees which are now charged separately during registration) for:

- i) New goalies. A goalie will be considered a “new” goalie if they have not previously played the position for any ringette association; or
- ii) existing goalies who have switched from using WORA equipment to their own equipment in the current season.

Rebate 2. A \$250 rebate for all goalies who provide their own equipment.

Conditions

In order to be eligible for either Rebate 1 or Rebate 2, the player must:

1. play with their team for the entire season;
2. either be a ‘full-time’ goalie and play only the goalie position (i.e. not play out as a skater) or be part of a 2-goalie rotation. Players on teams where 3 or more players rotate through the goalie position will NOT be eligible for the rebate;
3. have paid the West Ottawa Ringette Association registration fees in full for the applicable season, in accordance with the Associations payment timeline requirements.

Goalies meeting the above conditions may apply for the rebate by completing the “Goalie Rebate Application” form and submitting the form to the West Ottawa Ringette Association Treasurer.

All applications will be reviewed by the West Ottawa Ringette Association Executive before rebates are issued in order to ensure the above conditions have been met.

Exceptions will be dealt with on a case by case basis by the Executive.
