Team Formation Committee Report (Committee :Nathan, Cristina, Katrina, Steven, Marissa)



Discussion: U16 and U19 Club Teams **U16** - 10 Players (1 player from U19 playing down) 1 male goalie 5 all gender players 4 female only - some willing to move to all genders to play. Declare an all gender team - need ALL players to commit to attending all games/practices. Need 2 players (asked KRA) to form a roster. IF we are unable to get additional players - find our U16 male goalie somewhere else to play and ask Kelowna to combine with us to form 2 female only teams (smaller teams).

U19 - enough players to have a female only team (2 from Kelowna, 1 from Open). An all-gender (4 players (1 male goalie, 3 female)) would go play with Kelowna's U19 all-gender team. Possibility that the male goalie is not going to play ringette this season. Overall - WRA U19 Female Team, KRA U19 Female Team, All-Gender Team (mostly of Kelowna players. KRA U19 has 3 female goalies – could be one for each team.

President's Report (Nathan K)

Two small U12 teams. Player movement committee has been provided with all player movement requests.

U14 zone team - The coaches that were not selected filed an appeal with Ringette BC that is being dealt with by outside parties. Team was supposed to be announced yesterday but there was a delay as the coach who filed the appeal said the team shouldn't be announced until the appeal has been reviewed and either approved/denied.

All U14 players who evaluated for zone will practice with the U14 club team until this appeal is sorted and the team roster is announced.

U16 zone team (South) is formed - 6 players evaluated and all made it.

Bottle Drive - September 21, 2024 CNB is booked, insurance is paid for. We can take the bottles to the West Kelowna Depot

VP's Report (Cristina J) Nothing to report



Registrar Report (Katrina A) 117 registrations. Mark (zone coordinator) reached out - the AP option for any player that is playing Team BC has been set up with WRA to register

Ice Ambassador Report (Tim W) *Heaters in the stands at Royal Lepage and Jim Lind will not be turned on until early October.*

Treasurer's Report (Katelyn T) *Budget \$52,000 - currently at \$53,000 - 1 player outstanding payment (\$475). \$2,400 credit card payments pending – from payment plan.*

Director of Sport Development Report (Steven K) Come Try Ringette (September 22, 2024) is covered. Each team gets 2 sessions of power skating (through AK Hockey) – coaches to set up. Goalie clinic - need goalie gear to have a Come Try Goalie (as per Rob we have 10 sets of pads)

\$25 per session for any player that comes out and volunteers for Come Try Ringette events.

Director of Equipment Report (Rob L) Setting up an online site with BC Sportswear (Katrina and Kim helping). Rob ordered "C" and "A" for all teams.

Director of Officials Report (Darrell D) Level 1 course being run in the Okanagan (only course being run). Mike submitted a form to intake new officials. Policy for number of new officials?

Director of Promotions Report (Kristie M) Fudge Fundraiser - mid-October. Will need help with sorting. Goal of \$8,000 funds raised.

Terry from the Recreation Guide asked if we wanted to be in the winter guide.

Director of Coaching Report (Marissa C) Working on sorting out coaches for all teams -FUN needs a head coach, they have many assistants. Currently working through all coaches to make sure they have the courses they need.

OK Autumn Blast - coaches may need to register before teams are formed to be sure they have a spot.
