## COVID-19 Update

### Respecting one another: BC Ministry of Health proof of COVID-19 vaccination guidelines

As we continue to work together to adjust to a new normal and follow provincial health guidelines during COVID-19, to keep our facilities and programs operating safely, we thank our recreation users for their continued kindness, patience, resilience and understanding.

Starting Sept. 13, 2021, the Province of BC requires that people show proof of vaccination to access certain non-essential indoor programs and events. Community members must provide proof of vaccination by showing their vaccine card and provincial government photo ID upon entering City recreation facilities, including **all indoor areas** such as lobbies, lounges, program rooms, gyms, fitness studios, pools, rinks, etc.

### Please respect our staff as they must follow these specific requirements:

- Adults age 19 years and older must show their vaccination card and provincial government photo ID
- Youth **spectators/fans** ages 12 to 18 years must show their vaccination card; no provincial government photo ID is required

### Exceptions to the vaccination card rule include:

- Children ages 11 and under
- Recreation **participants** ages 12 to 18 years
- Operational essential personnel (*coaches, teachers, instructors, referees, etc*)

### Please also:

- Stay home if you are sick
- Wear masks indoors when not in the field of play
- Sanitize hands when entering and leaving our facilities and programs
- Maintain safe social distancing
