



Volunteer Policy

The Westside Ringette Association is run by and depends on volunteers. There is an expectation that every family contribute some volunteer time in various association events throughout the season. This year we are tying in our volunteer hours with our registration discount. All families will be required to help with a minimum of 4 association events throughout the season plus attend the AGM in April. (Each event shift is generally 2 hours long) This will qualify each player in your family to receive a \$100 discount on their registration fees for the following season.

Families volunteer time is tracked throughout the year. If a family does not fulfill the requirements, no registration discount will be given.

Some examples of events that require our membership to volunteer are:

- Parades (decorating floats, walking in the parade)
- Assisting at Come Try Ringette Events
- TORL play days (weekend in October)
- PubNite
- Sweetheart tournament (personnel for Rink Marshall and hospitality tables)
- BC Provincial Championships (March 2018)

Other volunteer duties within our association are at a team level. These are duties that as a parent of a team member you are expected to help with. The following duties do not count towards the registration discount.

- Time Keeping at league games and tournaments
- Scorekeeping at league games and tournaments
- Shot Clock at league games and tournaments (U12 and above)
- Jersey Parent
- Selling WRA annual fundraiser tickets
- Any individual team fundraising
