Westside Youth Soccer Association – Sanitization Protocol

June 10th, 2020

Phase 1 of WYSA's back to play will occur at the 3 district fields Bylands, Gormans and Investors at Constable Neil Bruce Middle school, 2010 Daimler Rd, West Kelowna, BC.

These sanitizations protocols are enacted to help reduce the spread of the current COVID-19 pandemic. Help us keep everyone safe by staying home if you are sick, use hand sanitizer at the field and abide by all club COVID-19 health and safety policies and protocols.

Site Sanitization – disposable glove will be available (found in bin on site) to use when sanitizing

Before Program Starts

- Staff will wipe down ramp railings and gates with *sanitizer.
- Staff will wipe down the sign-in table with *sanitizer.

Between Sessions

- Staff will wipe down the sign-in table with *sanitizer.

After Program Ends

- Staff will wipe down the sign-in table with *sanitizer.
- Staff will wipe down the ramp railings and gates with *sanitizer.

Equipment Sanitization

Before Program Starts

- Ensure participants have sanitized their soccer ball prior to entering the training field. Provide *sanitization fluid if necessary (spray ball with bleach solution).

After each session

- Players will take personal cones and drop them in one of the designated “cone sanitization” bins.
- Players will have their soccer ball *sanitized as they leave the field (spray ball with bleach solution).

After Program Ends

- Staff will deposit all cones into “cone sanitization” bins.
- Staff will clean all cones with a *bleach solution before putting them away for the next program.

***See handout** for making bleach solutions for disinfection – in WYSA COVID-19 binder kept in the bin at CNB. Staff will make bleach solution following the instructions on the handout. Commercial sanitization fluid can be substituted if available.
