As the world of sport keeps evolving there is now greater emphasis put on issues outside of the simple x's and o's of the game that require our attention. Things like concussion awareness and safe contact are now mandatory courses for you and your staff to take. Well, there is now another training module that will be mandatory from Football Canada and is in the discussion phase for being mandatory for all sport in Alberta. We think its best that we all try to get ahead of the curve on this issue. It is called SAFE SPORT and deals with a Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport which calls for all sporting environments to be free from physical, sexual and psychological abuse. The Safe Sport Training module aligns with those values. It equips coaches, administrators and others to make decisions that promote athletes' physical and mental wellbeing and empowers sporting organizations to foster a culture that contributes to athlete success. We may not think things like these can happen in our sport but one just has to remember the Jerry Sandusky situation at Penn State to see that they can. Since we are in a holding pattern for football in Alberta it's a good time for you and your coaches to follow this link Safesport (coach.ca) and take the training. Its only about 45 minutes and it will show up your NCCP Locker providing you enter your number (or if you don't have a number it will create one for you) You can always email Sally in our office at admin@footballalberta.ab.ca and she can find your NCCP number for you if you've misplaced it.
