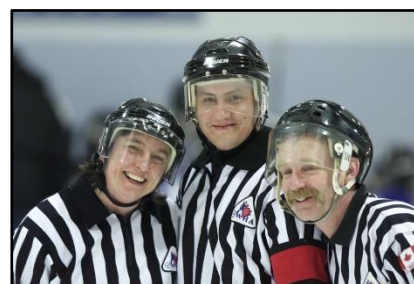

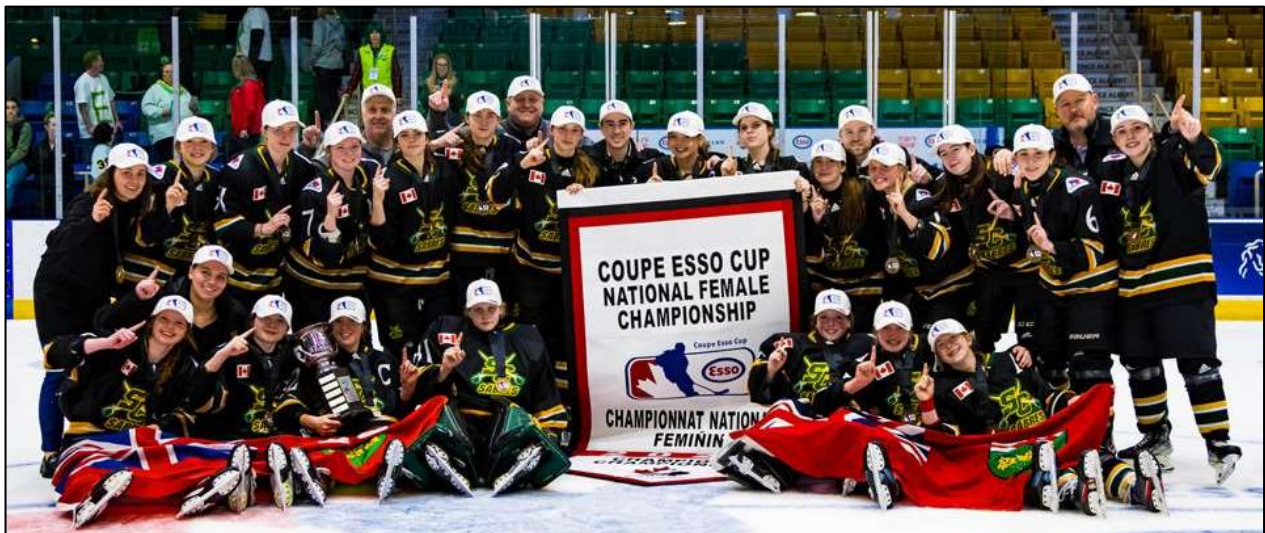

DISCIPLINE REPORT: 2022-2023



U9 Division

There were 4 suspensions issued in this division.

- 1 from U9A, 2 from U9B and 1 from U9C.
 - The U9 C suspension was issued to a Coach.

U11 Division

There were 34 suspensions at the U11 Level.

Players:

- U11 BB level received the most suspensions with 8. This represents 24% of the U11 suspensions.
- U11 HL with had 5, U11 AA had 3, and U11 A and B with 2 each.
- U11 C division had 1.

Coaches:

- Had 13 of the 34 suspensions at the U11 level which represents 38%.
- U11 A and HL coaches received the most suspensions with 4 each.
- U11 BB and B coaches received 2 each.
- U11AA coaches receiving 1.

Summary:

Disputing an officials call (GM21 Rule 11.2e) was the most frequently called suspension with 9 or 26% of all U11 suspensions. The next highest suspension, body checking (GM20 Rule 11.1e), accounted for 5 or 15% of the total suspensions.

U13 Division

There were 114 suspensions at the U13 level.

Players:

- U13 AA division received the most suspensions at 23 or 20%.
- U13 A was the next highest with 22 or 19% of the total suspensions issued.
- U13 B was at 18, while U13 BB was at 11.
- U13 HL had 7 or 6% while U13 C had 5 or 4%
- U13 DS had 2 or 1% of the total suspensions.

Coaches:

- Had 26 or 23% of all suspensions at the U13 level.
- U13 HL had the most suspensions with 6 or 5%.
- U13 A and BB level at 5 or 5% each.
- U13 C level had 4 at 4%.
- U13 AA and B division at 3 or 3% each.

Summary:

Unsportsmanlike Conduct (GM20 Rule 11.1e) was the highest suspension called with 17 or 15%. U13 BB received the most GM20 (Rule 11.1e) calls, with 4 or 24% of the total GM20 (Rule 11.1e) calls issued. U13 A and B had 3 each, while U13 AA had 1, U13 C with 2 and U13 HL with 1. Disrespectful and Abusive Behaviour (GM21 Rule 11.2e) was the next highest suspension called with 11 or 10%.

U15 Division

There were 266 suspensions at the U15 level.

Players:

- A level received the most with 76 suspensions or 29% of all U15 suspensions.
- BB had 44, U15 B had 37 and U15 AA had 32.
- Suspension called most often was Checking from Behind (GM55 Rule 7.5a) with 65 suspensions or 25%.
- A level received the most GM55 (Rule 7.5a) suspensions with 28, followed by the AA level with 10.
- Next highest suspension was Disrespectful and Abusive Behaviour (GM21 Rule 11.2e) with 21 suspensions.
- HL received the most of these types of suspensions with 7.
- A and BB received 4 each with B at 3, the C group at 2 and AA at 1.

Coaches:

- Had 41 or 15% of all suspensions at the U15 level.
- B group had the most suspensions with 11 or 28%.
- BB and HL levels were at 10 or 24% each.
- A level had 6 while the AA had 4.

Summary:

The suspension called most often was Checking from Behind (GM55 Rule 7.5a) with 65 suspensions or 25%. The U15 A level received the most GM55 (Rule 7.5a) suspensions with 28, followed by the AA level with 10. The next highest suspension was Disrespectful and Abusive Behaviour (GM21 Rule 11.2e) with 21 suspensions. The HL group received the most of these types of suspensions with 7, the A and BB groups received 4 each with B at 3, the C group at 2 and AA at 1.

U18 Division

There were 482 suspensions at the U18 level.

Players:

- 405 player suspensions issued at this level.
- U18 A had the highest number of suspensions at 98 or 25% of the total player suspensions.
- The AA and BB were both at 20%.
- The B group had 79 or 20%, the HL group at 44 or 11% while C group had 10 and the DS group had 9.

Coaches:

- Had 77 or 16% of all suspensions at this level.
- U18 A group had 20 or 26% and the B level at 18 or 23% of the total coaches' suspensions.
- U18 BB had 16, the AA and HL groups had 10 each.

Summary:

Checking from Behind (GM55 Rule 7.5a) was the suspension most called at this level with 78 or 16%. The A group received the most of these types of suspensions with 26 or 33%. The BB group received 17 or 22% and the AA and B groups at 15 or 19% each. The next highest suspension called was Head Contact (GM41.13 Rule 7.6) with 60 suspensions or 12%. The BB and B levels received 13 each, while the A level had 12 followed by HL with 4 and C with 3.

U22 Division

There were 110 suspensions issued at this level.

Players:

- The AA level received the most suspensions with 59 or 63% of all player suspensions at this level.
- The U22 A level received 18 or 19%, while the HL level received 18%

Coaches:

- Had 16 of the or 15% of all the suspensions at this level.
- AA had 7 or 44%, A group had 5 or 31% and the HL group had 4 or 25 % of total coach suspensions.

Summary:

Checking from Behind (GM55 Rule 7.5a) was called most often at this level with 23. While the next highest suspension called was Head Contact (GM41.13 Rule 7.6b) with 13.

SENIOR

There were 38 Senior level suspensions.

Players:

- The Senior B received the most suspensions with 12, Senior HL with the next highest at 8.
- Senior A, BB and C all had 4 with AA at 3.

Coaches:

- 3 suspensions issued and all were for Unsportsmanlike Conduct (GM20 Rule 11.1e) at the Senior C level.

Summary:

While the suspensions were spread out amongst a number of different types, Unsportsmanlike Conduct (GM20 Rule 11.1e) was called 8 times.

Overall, this year there were 1048 suspensions called for this season.

The suspension called most often was Head Contact (GM41.13 Rule 7.6b) with 104 which represents 10% of all suspensions called. The U18 level received the most Checking from Behind suspensions with 78 or 8% of the suspensions. The next highest suspension called was Disrespectful and Abusive Behaviour (GM21 Rule 11.2e) with 102 or 10%. The U18 Level received the most GM21 (Rule 11.2e) suspension calls with 46. The U15 and U22 divisions were close behind with 20 and then 10.

This year, the U18 category received the highest number of suspensions with 482 of the 1048 or 46% of all suspensions. The next highest category receiving suspensions was U15 with 266 suspensions or 25%. The U18 A level received the highest number of suspensions with 117 or 11% of all suspensions. This was followed closely by the U18 BB at 99, U18 B with 96, the AA level at 91, HL at 54, and U18 C at 12, and DS at 10.

Coaching staff received 177 or 17% of all suspensions. Again, the U18 coaches received the most with 77 or 44% of all Coach suspensions. Coaches at the U15 level were next highest behind the U18 level with 41 or 23% of the suspensions.

This year there were 53 repeat offenders for the season.
There were 10 staff members and 43 players who were repeat offenders.
