 - ii. The executive board of Whitecourt Minor Hockey Association conducted a special meeting tonight, November 29th at 7:30PM. Decisions made at the meeting outlined below:
 - 1. Starting November 30, EVERY person participating and attending WMH events, practices and games MUST wear masks at all times. Players are exempt on the ice.
 - 2. Coaching staff and team staff who interact with the players must wear masks on the bench at all times and not he ice when not able to maintain 2 meter distance with the players.
 - e. COVID Person Duties: Jamie to look at other associations and write up a clear description of roles and responsibilities.

- f. Spectators: discussed possibility of limiting spectators. Not in favour at this time.
- g. Exhibition games: NAI is not controlling sanctions for games. Hockey Alberta will provide sanctions for exhibition games if we remain in open status. Must ensure you isolate for 14 days between switching cohorts. Also your team members should not stop in purple zones.
