- 4. Old Business
 - a. Registration numbers so far in each division *open for 7 days since July 1 U5- 1 U7-8 U9-15 U11-4 U13-2 U15-4 U18-3 No females yet*
 - b. Socks should we order now for everyone? Order now for everyone so that we have for the end of September. **Rand will contact** Top line and Stitch and Time for prices and then compare to the city like United Cycle then make best decision for WMH
 - c. Picture Day booked for Oct 20 and 21 Melissa will find a location (Trevor offered to use goalie shop?) limited poses, online ordering no one will have picture day and practice on the same day wants approved rosters ahead of time with proper spelling
 - d. Female Division asked for support from Hockey Alberta and brought up concerns with them and the Rocky Mountain League travel concerns. The president of the association was very helpful; they would be playing north of Calgary and Lethbridge, Medicine Hat etc. 2-3 games a weekend but could have a Sun night game at 6:00 p.m. could we join up with Onoway? Hockey Alberta is pulling some strings with the league city leagues don't want to travel out here either. A couple of names have been sent to Paul (Jenny Dickson, Kristy Aubin, Ashley) Younger age teams present greater challenges to find them a place to play no established teams within a few hours of us (U14,U17) **Paul and Trevor plan to do some follow up etc**.
 - e. Team works and how we move that along policy and procedures put out 'stuff' and got no response back - is there a better way to reach out to people rather than via email. Hand picked email went out as a survey -

lots of steps to complete. Random name generator 4 from each division head coaches, directors etc. (sent out 75 or so) he only got Morgan's back. Use google forms to send out to the whole association to make it easier on the folks completing the survey. Do a \$50 GC to motivate folks to fill it out? Add a choice to enter into a draw and provide their information. **Morgan to follow up**

- f. Team Genius to discuss viability with our association software for evaluations (also looked at Max Analytics - a little pricier) - try to work on perception of making it more 'fair' - trial for 1 division for 1 year - but hockey AB has entered into a partnership with Team Genius \$5-9/player set up evaluations for you - all the drills what you are looking for in each drill for the evaluators and then using a software mobile app to give a grade. Looking for a demo - trial for U11 to understand if it is useful. U15/U18 AA or AAA this may not work due to what the coaches may be looking for. Integrates with team snap - instantly can send a report to the parents. Cut down on the time spent. Plan to get feedback from parents on the trial run. Morgan next steps - get confirmed pricing, find out how Sherwood Park feels about it, Speak to Team Genius folks to give them a presentation on how the system works - what tech is needed? Will occur mid to late July.
