## PLAYER MOVEMENT AS A RESULT OF CONFLICT

\*Hockey Alberta deadline for carding players is January 10th. All requests to be released from a team must be completed before the deadline or will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

In the event the request is being made as a result of a conflict the player, parent(s), team must engage in the following:

- 1. Association members must follow the WMHA Team Communication Flow Chart.
  - a. Conflict resolution must be undertaken by all parties.
- 2. If unresolved, then a written request must be sent to the <u>Division Director</u> and <u>Appropriate VP</u>.
  - a. The Division Director will engage in documenting the conflict from all sides and assist in any clarification or resolution of the request.
- 3. If unresolved, all documentation will be sent to the WMHA Executive.
  - a. The President, Game and Conduct and 'Other' VP or a member at large will meet with all parties to attempt resolution of the conflict.
- 4. The conflict will either be resolved or the player will be released from the team.
  - a. If the player is released from the team The Player Development Director will determine player placement based on his/her evaluation.
  - b. Once placement is determined the player will be carded with the new team.
  - c. Player compensation, fundraising money and budget changes for teams will be addressed on a case by case basis.
- 5. The WMHA Executive is responsible for the final decision on all player movement.

a. Decisions made by the WMHA executive can be appealed. Refer to the appeal policy for details.
