Hello and welcome to the 2022-2023 hockey season and another year with the Yukon Female Hockey Club and the Yukon Wild. Again this season, we have the same great programs and some new processes that will help us cater to both the recreational players and the more competitive or "rep" players within the YFHC!

Once again, female players may opt to join the Yukon Female Hockey Club and skate once (sometimes twice) per week – a great way to enjoy hockey, learn the game and allow time for other activities.

Players may also sign up for the YHFC as a supplement to their house league and/or rep team hockey programming at a reduced rate.



Girls 1 Ice - This is our most successful ice time and when it's not broke, don't fix it! This is the entry to hockey and open to all girls aged 5-10 that are looking to learn the game in a stress-free, fun-filled environment. There will be one ice time per week with a focus on skill development and games that stress the fundamentals. This ice time will likely be 1:45-245 pm on Saturdays.

Girls 2 Ice - This group will be made up of primarily U11 as well as some U13 players and builds on the skills acquired through the Girls 1 session. Focusing on skill development and game play tactics, these players will also have access to intersquad games and exhibition games on some Sundays as they become available. As with Girls 1, players are guaranteed one ice time per week. This ice will take place Saturdays from 3-4pm.

Female Development Ice - This ice time is focused on the U15-U18 age group (with a few higher level U13s) and will be an up tempo, development-based program. This group will continue to develop more advanced skills and game play tactics and be exposed to some of the skills coaches available in town.

Yukon Wild Travel Teams - This year there will be groups of players that are privileged to be asked to attend tournaments representing the Yukon Wild Hockey Club. This year we have an independent evaluation committee that will provide perspective on which girls are at the travel/rep level for players in U11 and up. The evaluation will be based on the WMHA formal evaluation processes.
