



Batting Cage Mitigation Plan

June 17, 2021

Entry

- *All booking of batting cages should be done through the website and added by the coach via their RAMP login credentials. Screening of all participants must be done through the app before arriving at the batting cage.*

Social Distancing

- At no point will a softball event exceed the number of attendees (including players, coaches, umpires, association officials, volunteers, parents and other family members) noted as the maximum number by the Province of Ontario, or any relevant municipality or public health authority. Players, parents, and coaches must maintain (3M) social distancing.
- No physical contact between players or coaches (high fives etc. not allowed)

PPE and Equipment use at Batting cages

- The coach operating the batting machine will be required to sanitize hands before and after operating the pitching machine
- The coach will be responsible for wiping down the bat between uses.
- After the batting cage session is over, all the balls will be cleaned with soap and water (or bleach solution as noted above) by the coach and placed back into the bin.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use at the cages and provided by the player or team.

Food and Drink

- Players may not share any food or drink – water bottles must be labelled by name.
- Sunflower seeds and gum will not be allowed.
