### INJURY REPORTS & MEDICAL KIT

#### POLICY STATEMENT

The WPFC INCIDENT REPORT form shall be used to report injury incidents. Parents should be made aware that their player is covered by insurance during all sanctioned events. Similarly the converse is true. Players are not covered by insurance in “unsanctioned” events.

Each team is given a medical kit when team equipment is picked up. The medical kit will be stocked with emergency supplies such as instant ice bags, tape, Band-Aids, and tensor bandages etc. There will be a second restocking during in mid-June for those who require additional supplies.

Please remember that the medical kit is for emergencies. If you have players with chronic injuries that require icing after each game, or at every half time, we ask that you bring a small cooler of ice. If you have players who have chronic injuries that require taping every game and practice, we ask that you have them supply their own tape.

If you require items not supplied in the medical kit, your team will be responsible for purchasing those items.

#### Rules & Guidelines

Coaches and bench officials shall get injured players off the playing field as quickly as possible within the normal realms of responsible safety.

Regardless if a claim is to be made, the WPFC INCIDENT REPORT form must be completed within 48 Hours of the accident and a copy filed in the WPFC office
