REPORTING SUSPICION OF CHILD ABUSE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

POLICY STATEMENT

Winnipeg Phoenix FC's guideline (adopted from Commit to Kids) for external reporting procedures regarding this type of incident:

External Reporting Procedure

If a child is believed to have been sexually abused, the obligation under law is to report the incident to the child's parent, a child welfare agency and/or a law enforcement agency. Failure to report may constitute an offence under the Manitoba Child Welfare Act. Additionally, it may constitute professional misconduct for an individual in a position of trust or an ethical violation for individuals who are registered with professional associations. This duty to report applies even if the information is told in confidence.
