

TOURNAMENTS AND TRAVEL

POLICY STATEMENT

WPFC teams shall only participate in (WYSA or MSA) sanctioned tournaments. Teams must get permission to enter tournaments from the Technical Director. Teams shall not participate in any tournament that is not sanctioned by (WYSA or MSA). Any coach or team willingly doing so shall face automatic suspension and severe disciplinary action.

Rules & Guidelines

Out-of-Town Tournaments and Exhibition Games

Competition is only permitted with MSA sanctioned teams.

Approval must be obtained from the Technical Director by teams prior to participating in exhibition games or tournaments.

Guest players:

Every attempt should be made to cater to WPFC Team players first. In the event that these are a demonstrated shortage of WPFC players, Teams may invite guests to participate in tournaments and travel.

All guest players require approval by the Technical Director and the Club Board.

Special Events:

Normal Guest player contained in section 2.3 may be waived for special events which occur in the pre or post season time period of December to February. Organisers considering entering a special event during this time period must apply to Board in writing for sanction, with sufficient lead-time for due consideration, and specifying, minimally, the following:

- a) Name, date and location of the event.
- b) Name, address and phone number of the event contact person or organiser.
- c) Number of players participating.
- d) Method and criteria for player selection.
- e) Corporate sponsors anticipated, if any.
- f) Name under which the team will operate.



Sanction or denial of the request will be by motion of Board, however, organisers should be aware that WYSA, MSA or CSA approvals shall also be necessary, and that obtaining such approvals is the responsibility of the organisers.

TRAVEL PERMITS

Policy

Travel permits shall be required by teams traveling to tournaments or exhibition games outside of Manitoba. Travel permits are available at the MSA office. WPFC approval then WYSA approval and lastly MSA approvals are required to be obtained in that order. Sufficient notice is required. Coaches and Managers of Teams failing to follow this policy shall be automatically suspended and are in jeopardy of facing severe disciplinary action.
