UNIFORM, DRESS CODE AND LOGO

POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of WPFC that all staff members, team officials and players of Premier and Developmental teams adhere to the club's dress code. The dress code is intended to show pride in taking part in the program and develops discipline in the individuals that wear the uniform.

- 1. Staff members (coaches, assistants, and managers) must wear Club-approved clothing at all Club and team functions. This will include, but not limited to: meetings, training, and games.
- 2. All players, when representing the Club, must wear Club uniforms, training gear or tracksuits.

Note: Uniforms are not to be worn at practices.

3. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in the person(s) refused attendance at the event, and may lead to dismissal from the team for repeated infractions.

The Club recognises that a standard set of colours may provide for recognition of teams when participating in tournaments, championships, provincial competition, national competition or league play; cost benefits for equipment purchase; and a unifying influence for players, team officials and followers. Supplementary clothing is entirely optional, however, explicit specifications for products bearing the Club logo are designed to provide season-to-season continuity and reduce costs to parents.

Rules & Guidelines

Logo

The Club logo is available in digital form and shall be this graphic.

Colours

Club colours shall be sky-blue, red, white and/or black.

The Board will determine the approved Club uniform. There will be no exceptions.

The Club will purchase and supply all Premier and Development-League teams with the approved home and away uniforms.

The Club will retain from each Premier and Development-League Team player a shirt deposit equivalent to the cost of the shirts. This deposit will be in the form of a post-dated cheque and will be refundable upon return of the shirts at the end of the season. If the team or player fails to return all the equipment then they will be charged for the replacement items.



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Supplementary Clothing

Players, as a matter of personal choice, may purchase supplementary clothing. Team officials shall make no stipulation, or others requiring the purchase of supplementary clothing and no player shall be penalised for not participating in a purchase plan.

Coaches and other team officials must participate in the purchase of supplementary clothing on an equal basis with all players.

Supplementary clothing, purchased as team wear, shall comply with Club colours and specifications to qualify to bear the Club logo and require prior written approval from the Board.
