### Pool Round

- 1. Teams are divided into two pools and each team plays two games within their pool on separate diamonds.
- 2. The home team is the team with the better record during the regular season.
- 3. Games must be played to their conclusion (6 innings)
- 4. The mercy rule is in effect.
- 5. Games can not end in a tie.
- 6. All other rules in effect during the regular season still apply.

#### Medal Round

- 1. If two teams are tied after the pool round, the team with the fewest runs against per defensive outs is placed higher.
- 2. If more than two teams are tied after the pool round, the teams are ranked according to those with the fewest runs against per defensive outs.
- 3. The home team in the Championship Game is the team with the better record during the regular season.

#### Three teams tied formula (use these in the order they are listed)

1) Runs Against
Defensive Outs (≈ Lowest Ratio Advances) (Games between tied teams only)

Example for 13U

Ratio .238
In this example, Team A is declared first For tie-breaking procedures if a game is forfeited, the final score will be recorded as 1 run per scheduled inning (6 for 11U, 7 for 13U, 15U and 18U), or the actual score for the team awarded the win, whichever **run differential** is greater. This is the score that will be used if necessary in the formula.

- Runs For
   Offensive Outs (= Highest Ratio Advances) (Games between tied teams only)
- Runs Against
  Defensive Outs (= Lowest Ratio Advances) (All games included)
- Runs For Offensive Outs (= Highest Ratio Advances) (All games included)
- Three-way coin flip.
