- \*Guest players must be registered with a lower division team in the WWSL.
- \*A maximum of 3 guest players including guest & or youth players are permitted to play in a designated game.
- \*All guest players must have valid MSA ID cards and must be present at game.
- \*One guest player only per permit.
- \*Youth players who are registered with WYSA must use a WYSA youth to senior permit form and must have a valid WYSA ID card present at the game.
- \*For Outdoor; Guest permit is to be mailed to the WWSL by Match Referee with game sheet.
- \*For Indoor; Guest permit is to be kept with game sheets in WWSL binders.
- \*Guest players are not permitted to play in playoffs or MSA Cup games.
- \*Guest players who are under 18, one team staff must have their CPIC/CAR & must be present at the game.
- \*No youth players are permitted in the WWSL Co-ed Divisions.
- \*Guest players for Co-ed teams must be registered with a lower division Co-ed team in the WWSL.
- \*A maximum number of 12 call ups per receiving team per season allowed.
