Williams Lake Youth Soccer Association (WLYSA) invites photographers to submit a project proposal to the WLYSA Board of Directors for the 2020 Spring Outdoor Soccer Season Team and Individual Photos.

Project: 2020 Spring Outdoor Soccer Season Team and Individual Photos

Description

WLYSA is host to approximately 100 house teams and 10 rep teams. Each player and coach receive a team photo if they are present on the day photos are taken. Further, each sponsor receives a photo of the team they sponsored.

Individual photos have been offered in the past to WLYSA members. Individual photos will be offered at the discretion of the photographer and will be the sole responsibility of the photographer for payment and distribution.

Timeline

The 2020 Spring Outdoor Soccer Season runs from Late April to June 20, 2020. Team and Individual photos must be taken at scheduled practice or game times early in the season and ready for distribution to parents and sponsors by June 5, 2020.

Additional Details

- Photographer to coordinate with all division the date photos will be taken.
- Photographer will be expected to reschedule if the weather is not optimal or the team has a low player turnout.
- The photographer should have the ability to shoot indoors utilizing the Esler Clubhouse in the event that weather has delayed photos.
- All digital work is to be completed by the photographer. Each photo must include Team Name, WLYSA Logo and Team Sponsor Logo.

Please submit a project proposal outlining your experience, proposed pricing structure (or options for pricing structures), examples and ideas on how you would make the 2020 photos an easy process for everyone involved.
