



Dogs at Esler Soccer Complex

Adopted March 2, 2020

Purpose

Williams Lake Youth Soccer Association (WLYSA) wishes to respect the rights of spectators to bring their dogs to the Esler Sports Complex, recognizing that the safety of players, referees, parents, and others is of paramount concern.

With the above in mind, it is necessary for dog owners to ensure their dog is appropriately handled, and respectful to others at all times. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all dog owners must comply with the following rules:

Regulations

1. All dogs must be on a leash.
2. All dogs must be accompanied by an adult.
3. Dogs must remain off the playing fields while WLYSA activities are taking place.
4. Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and appropriately disposing of their feces into the dumpsters.
5. If at anytime the dog is being disrespectful to players, volunteers, or other spectators, the owner may be asked to leave the dog at home for the remainder of the season.
6. Disrespectful behaviours may include: excessively barking, lunging at others, growling with hackles raised, bearing teeth, or biting.
7. WLYSA does not condone leaving dogs in vehicles during hot weather, and requires that owners take appropriate measures to ensure the proper care of their animals.
