FINANCIAL REPORT (Claire)

2020/21 Season

- Hoping to have regular calls with OWHA
- Hockey Canada is controlling what is going to happen in line with the Government.
- There are 3 options; Return in Sept, Return in Jan, No return
- One thing is for sure it is guaranteed to look different
- At this point there is no plan and no set dates
- Pre-registration is permissible
- Collection of fees is prohibited
- Distributing permission to skates are prohibited
- Releases are permissible
- Considering pre-registration
- Hockey may not be affordable for some families this year
- ACTION: Send Bulletin from OWHA with minutes
- ACTION: Send email to members with update bulletin
- Certification for coaches is under review
- Rowan's Law changes: if a player leaves a game with a head injury, they are not permitted to return until cleared by a medical doctor
- Structure for Atom will be the same as Novice. One of the major changes is the tryout structure. Structure description on OWHA site
- ACTION: Robin will send out the document outlining the changes
- OWHA has new registration system which will allow digital game sheets using a new program this year

BYLAW AMENDMENTS (All)

- Voted live on 9 changes to bylaw and constitution

 - It is a lot of money for the association to be out and is becoming very difficult to collect from teams
 - Some tournaments require an association cheque
 - The fees will just need to be collected in advance but a cheque can still be issued by the association
