Good Afternoon,

Your Outdoor 2022 team has been activated and you can start inviting players and coaches to register to your team.

Please encourage your coaches and managers to register quickly so that we can include them on future league emails for the Outdoor 2022 season. This email is only going to the person who registered the team for Outdoor 2022.

CWSA ID Cards

- All CWSA players and team officials must have a CWSA issued ID card in order to participate in games.
- Players need to be registered to their team before coming to the CWSA office to get their card.
 Please make sure your players and coaches are aware that they need to register online first,
 before booking in to get an ID card. Registrations can no longer be completed at the CWSA office and must be completed online. Prior to your arrival.
- The CWSA office is open <u>BY APPOINTMENT ONLY</u>. There are NO WALK-INS for CWSA ID cards. Players and coaches must <u>book an appointment</u> to get their ID card.

Registration Tutorial

• How to register players to your team for the Outdoor 2022 season.

General Roster Information

- The maximum roster size per team is 25 players (applies to 11v11 and 8v8)
- A maximum of 20 players can dress for a game (applies to both 11v11 and 8v8)
- Teams must register a minimum of one (1) team official 24 hours prior to the start of the team's first league game. Teams who fail to do so will be assessed the appropriate penalty as defined in the Schedule of Fees and Penalties.
- CWSA players and team officials need to have a CWSA ID Card in order to participate in games.
 The card must be presented to the referee at each game.
 No Card = No Play, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The player transfer deadline for the Outdoor 2022 season is Thursday, July 28th.

Police Clearances (CPICs)

- Team officials (except those registered to Over 40 teams) need to provide a valid police clearance to the CWSA office prior to participating. Police clearances must be re-done every 3 years. Please have your coaches contact office@mycwsa.ca for a volunteer letter.
- If you have a police clearance on file with another organization (ex: CMSA, CUSA, etc.) we will
 accept it if it was issued within 3 years. Please contact the organization to have it sent to the
 CWSA.

League Fees Reminder

- The next instalment of league fees is due by Tuesday, April 26, 2022
- The final instalment of league fees is due by Tuesday, May 17, 2022

 - What positions do you need to fill (keeper, defence, midfielders, forwards, etc.).
 - Contact Information (email, phone number)
