



WHAT TO DO IF YOUR REFEREE NO-SHOWS

1

The game must be played

2

If the referee does not show up by the scheduled start time, a team official or designated individual from either team shall step in to referee the game

If no team official or designate is available, the players themselves shall self-manage the match

3

Both teams are responsible for ensuring the match is played. The game should begin as soon as possible and must start within ten (10) minutes for 11v11 or five (5) minutes for Boarded, 7v7, and 8v8.

The game time shall be adjusted to reflect any delay, and minimum game duration rules still apply for the result to count.

4

If one team refuses to play, that team defaults the match and the other team is awarded the win; if both teams refuse to play, the match is recorded as a game not played with no points awarded.

5

The completed game sheets must be signed by a designate from both teams and submitted to the CWSA immediately following the game.
