## CWSA CALGARY CLASH TOURNAMENT 2020 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Location: The Calgary Soccer Centre – Outdoor Turf Fields
Dates: April 25 & 26, 2020



# IF NOT SPECIFICALLY NOTED TO THE CONTRARY, CWSA/ASA/FIFA RULES SHALL APPLY

#### **8v8 RULES OF THE GAME**

All matches will be played in accordance with FIFA Laws of the Game, except where noted below:

- There is no stop time in 8v8 games.
- Each game will consist of two 30 minute halves with a 3 minute half time break.
- There is no limit to the number of substitutions a team can make at any single stoppage in play.
- **Goalkeepers are not permitted to punt or drop kick the ball.** Infringement; Indirect free kick to opposing team, at point of infraction. Goalkeepers may kick the ball from the ground, throw the ball, or roll the ball.
- Goal Kicks: Ball may not land inside the 1/3 of field that contains the other teams goal. Infringement; Throw-in for the opponent at either touchline at the centre of the field.
- Free Kicks: Opposing players must be 5m from ball, prior to kick being taken.
- Offside: In effect in the attacking 1/3rd of the field (the 1/3rd of field that contains the other team's goal).

## **GENERAL**

- Changes to the roster will only be entertained until 12pm on Thursday April 23, 2020
- Rosters are not to exceed 25 players. A maximum of 20 players may be dressed by each team per game
- CWSA reserves the right to move teams to a different tier subject to the team's submitted roster and division availability
- The Tournament Coordinators reserve the right to change the game schedule. All changes will be clearly posted on the CWSA website and emailed to the primary team contact.
- Each team is required to have a minimum of 6 players on the field at all times. If a team falls below the minimum, the game shall be abandoned and this team shall forfeit the game
- If team colours clash, the Home team will change to alternate/bibs. Referee shall determine colour clash
- The Home team will supply 2 game balls
- Game sheets will be provided to each team prior to the start of the Tournament (they can be picked up with the tournament package at tournament headquarters).

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- All players & coaches must be registered for the 2020 Outdoor Season with their local district no later than 12pm on Thursday April 23, 2020 in order to participate
- <u>ALL players registered outside of CWSA</u> will be verified with their local district prior to being deemed eligible to play in the tournament.
- Any player NOT registered with a sanctioned league must complete and submit a Temporary Guest Player form to the CWSA by April 15, 2020
- All players must be aged 16 or older at the time of play
- Any player or coach deemed to be "Not in good standing" or who is currently serving a suspension with their local District/Association will not be eligible to participate in the tournament
- Players may only play for one team in the tournament.
- A District ID Card <u>or</u> a Government issued photo ID are required for all players and coaches and must be presented to the referee prior to each game.

## **GAME RESULTS/POINT SYSTEM**

- All games, shall be two 30 minute halves with a 3 minute half time break.
- A game must have been played for 40 minutes or longer for the result to stand
- For Consolation and Championship Finals If the game is tied at the end of regulation time the determination of the final score will be conducted through penalty kicks as per FIFA Rules.
- Points will be awarded as follows: Win = 3 points; Tie = 1 point; Shutout = 1 point; Forfeiture = 5-0 win = 4 points
- Standings will be determined by total points at the completion of the round robin

- The following criteria will be used to determine the final standings if two (2) or more teams have an equal number of points at the end of the round robin.
  - i. Results against each other (points first then goal difference),
  - ii. Greater goal difference over all,
  - iii. Most goals for,
  - iv. Penalty kicks as per FIFA Rules
  - v. If, at the discretion of the CWSA, kicks from the penalty mark cannot be scheduled, a winner will be determined using a coin toss.

## **DISCIPLINE**

- For any red cards in any tournament games, please refer to the CWSA Discipline Code <u>and contact the tournament</u> <u>organizers immediately</u> at <u>office@mycwsa.ca</u> and <u>derek@mycwsa.ca</u>
- All suspensions received during tournament play will carry over into CWSA regular league games.
- No protest shall be allowed concerning the referee and his/her decision.

- The tournament entry fee is due upon registration
- Please be advised, teams that pull out of the tournament after the tournament registration deadline will be assessed a \$100 administration fee. There will be **NO** refund for teams that pull out once the alignment is posted.
