# IF NOT SPECIFICALLY NOTED TO THE CONTRARY, CWSA/ASA/FIFA RULES SHALL APPLY

#### GENERAL

- Teams will be placed together with other teams who have indicated the same or similar level of play. CWSA reserves the right to move teams to a different tier subject to the team's roster and division availability.
- Rosters are not to exceed 25 players, A maximum of 20 players may be dressed by each team per game
- Each team is required to have a minimum of four (4) players on the field at all times. If a team falls below the minimum, the game shall be abandoned and this team shall forfeit the game
- The CWSA reserves the right to change the game schedule. Changes will be emailed to the main team contact for affected teams, and will be posted to the CWSA website.
- If team colours clash, the Home team will change to alternate jerseys/pinneys. Referee shall determine colour clash
- The Home team will supply two (2) game balls.

# ELIGIBILITY

- Players may only play for **ONE** team in the tournament
- Players must be registered for the 2021-22 Indoor Season with their local district. Any player **NOT** registered with a sanctioned league must submit a **Temporary Guest Player form** and payment to the CWSA by **March 30, 2022.**
- <u>ALL players registered outside of CWSA</u> must be verified with their local district prior to being deemed eligible to play in the tournament.
- A District ID Card <u>or</u> a Government issued photo ID is required for all players and Team Officials and must be presented to the referee prior to each game.
- For Open division(s), players must be 16 years of age or older at the time of play.
- For Over 30 division(s), players must be 30 years of age or older at the time of play.
- For the Over 40 division(s), players must be 40 years of age or older at the time of play.

#### GAMESHEETS

- Teams will print their own game sheets online from the CWSA's game sheet website.
  - Game sheet login details and instructions will be sent to team contacts by April 7, 2022.
- Teams are to bring ONE game sheet for each game.

#### GAME RESULTS/POINT SYSTEM

- All games shall be 50 minutes (2 x 25 minute halves).
- For Consolation and Championship Finals If the game is tied at the end of regulation time the determination of the final score will be conducted through penalty kicks as per FIFA Rules.
- Points will be awarded as follows: Win = 3 points; Tie = 1 point; Shutout = 1 point; Forfeiture = 5-0 win = 4 points
- Standings will be determined by total points at the completion of the round robin
- The following criteria will be used to determine the final standings if two (2) or more teams have an equal number of points at the end of the round robin.
  - i. Results against each other (points first then goal difference),
  - ii. Greater goal difference over all,
  - iii. Most goals for,
  - iv. Penalty kicks as per FIFA Rules,
  - v. Coin toss.

#### DISCIPLINE

- A Discipline Committee will be established for the Tournament if a hearing is requested. A coach or manager may request a hearing within one hour of the completion of the game. Discipline for red and yellow cards may be passed along by the to the appropriate leagues by the Discipline Committee.
- For any red cards in any tournament games, please refer to the CWSA Discipline Code. Suspensions received during tournament play will carry over into CWSA regular league games.

# PROTESTS

- No protest shall be allowed concerning the referee and their decision.
- Protests must be made in writing by the registered coach/manager accompanied by a \$50 fee and delivered to a Tournament Coordinator within one hour of completion of the game in question. A decision will be delivered within one hour of receipt of the protest.

### OTHER

- For any errors or omissions, please refer to the current CWSA Rules/Regulations or contact the CWSA Office/Tournament Coordinators.
- Please be advised, teams that pull out of the tournament after the tournament registration deadline will be assessed a \$100 administration fee. There will be **NO** refund for teams that pull out once the alignment is posted.

# THE MANAGER OR COACH OF EACH TEAM IS REQUESTED TO COME TO TOURNAMENT HEADQUARTERS PRIOR TO YOUR FIRST GAME TO CHECK IN.
