COVID-19 INFORMATION

From the Leduc Recreation Centre:

Masking – Masks are required in all areas unless you are participating in an activity. Please help our staff by being mindful of always wearing your mask.

Restriction Exemption Program – The LRC is and REP facility, under AHS. Please be aware:

- All tournament participants 12 years of age an older will be screened at the entrance. This includes athletes, coaches, spectators, etc.
- Anyone under 11 will not be screened.

What will the screening process look like and what will I need:

- As a REP facility, those required to be screened must provide one of the following:
- Proof of vaccination status with QR code (2 doses required with a minimum of 14 days since the last dose was administered).
- ♦ Personal ID 18+
- A negative PCR test that was issued in the past 72 hours prior to accessing the facility.
- A medical exemption document.

Alberta Restrictions Exemption Program, including details for accepted negative tests.

Please note that as of November 15th, the vaccine record accepted will be a QR Code provided by AHS (for AB residents). For out of province travellers, our Province is working to scan the visiting QR codes. The facility will download other

All individuals must complete the <u>Alberta Health Daily Screening Checklist</u> before heading to the arena. Anyone with symptoms should stay home and follow the guidance on contacting 811 or completing the <u>AHS Online Assessment Tool</u>.

COVID PROCEDURE — GAME SPECIFIC

Reminder that coaching staff & injured players (not dressed) on the bench, and minor officials must wear their mask. Players will wear masks except when participating in physical activity (ice / warm-up).

Be mindful or others and maintain physical distance whenever possible.

There will be no handshake following the game, please do your cheer in your respective end and exit the ice surface. Medals will not be put on the athletes. Team staff will be given the medals for their team.

WARM UP SPACES

Teams may use the track for warm up (located up the stairs in front of the gym, 2nd floor), with the supervision of a **coach**. Please follow the flow of direction for the day. Teams may also use space in the corners of the track for warm-up/stretching.

The Wood Tournament has booked space in the LRC for the duration of the weekend for teams to warm-up as well. It is either ½ of the Fieldhouse or 1/3 of the Courts identified on the map. Teams are not permitted to warm-up/run, unless in these designated areas. Please keep any music to a low volume and be aware of other facility patrons.
