

## High Performance Centre 2020-2021

Water Polo Saskatchewan High Performance Centre program is <u>NOT</u> a substitution to your local club competitive program. This is an <u>ADDITIONAL</u> training service available to complete your club's program and meet the Long-Term Athlete Development requirements for the Competitive Stream.

## **Objectives:**

WPS will be facilitating this program for targeted athletes to participate in the provincial team program. The privilege to be a part of this program will give athletes an opportunity to be one of those considered in a selection process to be a member of WPS provincial team in Water Polo Canada's 15U, 17U or Senior Leagues, in addition to any other Team Sask invitational tournaments.

## **Training Behaviour and Strike Policy:**

As mentioned above, this program is not a substitution to your local program. The High-Performance training program's goal is to further athlete development by increasing training opportunities in a focused environment. WPS will operate the practices on a "three-strike policy" by staff to ensure the training environment is conducive to all athlete's development. The procedures will go as follows:

- Strike 1
  - $\circ~$  (a) Athlete will be given a verbal warning if behavior shown does not create an environment conducive to learning.
    - (b) Athlete will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the training period and an email will be sent to parents and/or guardians to inform them of the behaviour.
- Strike 2 Athlete will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the practice and a formal meeting will be set up between the coaches and athletes' family (either in person or through a zoom call).
- Strike 3 Athlete will be dismissed from the program and be ineligible for consideration for selection to Team Sask rosters for the remainder of the season.

## Selection Policy:

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions and protocols in place by the local facilities, our program planning and selection may be dictated by the ever-changing health status throughout the province and host cities. WPS staff retain the right to follow the selection policy criteria outlined in our website.
