Come Try Ringette

This September will be our first ever *Come Try Ringette Month*! The Region will help support any association that wishes to participate with Marketing, Equipment and Training. If you are interested in participating, please let me know by June 1st so that I can help you get organized.

As in previous seasons, I would ask that all Associations reach out to me by June 1st to register their CTR event(s). I will be sending out a link to the registration page to all the Presidents later this month, so please try to get your board organized and settled on a date early. I will order all the materials needed for each Association and get them delivered in early July so that we are all organized and ready to go this fall.

We will also be offering a CTR certification course in September for those that wish to come. I will send out more information on this in the fall.

Fair Ice Policy and LTAD Compliance

Did you know that females drop out of sport between the ages of 9 and 14 75% more frequently than males do? Less than 15% of youth today get the daily activity they need to be healthy adults and sport is a great way to combat these numbers.

LTAD and our Fair Ice Policy were created with these facts in mind. It is not a tool to punish coaches or to inhibit development. It was designed to help keep our youth active, engaged and having fun.

The Fair Ice Policy and LTAD Compliance documents still appear to be confusing for many coaches and assistant coaches so we have decided to organize a mandatory education session for all coaches for the fall. This training will align with the Mandatory Rule Change clinic that all coaches have to attend so registration will be made available in the fall. Our hope is that through education, we can help ensure our coaches make better decisions and help keep our youth engaged and active for life.

A great start in this process is to encourage your coaches or potential coaches to take advantage of the FREE *NCCP Sport Initiation Program* that is being offered this summer. This training is available to anyone that is interested and a great tool for coaches and volunteers. As part of our 150 year Canadian Celebration, this course is being offered at no cost until August 2017, so please share this information with your association.
