Bench Staff Requirements

- All information on bench staff requirements can be found under Items 3 and 4 of the Coaching Section of the ORA Operating Manual at http://ontario-ringette.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/08/5.-Coaching-Development-06-2017.pdf, as an overview:
- Managers must complete the Emodule on the Ringette Canada Coaching site to qualify to be on a teams' bench as a Manager
- Trainers must complete the Standard First Aid and CPR course (Red Cross or St. Johns) to qualify to be on a team's bench as a trainer. Health Care Professionals such as a doctor, nurse, paramedic, fireman also qualify. Note that a change has been made and trainers no longer need any further training such as CSI or HTCP in order to qualify.
- Coaches In order to help coaches understand the qualifications needed for each age and division the ORA has created Coaching Pathways which outline all qualification requirements needed by age and division. This information will be available on the ORA website in the coming weeks.

Bench Staff Substitutions

All Bench Staff substitutions must be approved by the ORA office prior to the applicable sanctioned event. This form can now be completed online to make things much simpler.

Coaching Registration

Coaches now have two options to register.

- Team Specific TRF Registration as usual
- Non Team Specific Independent Coach Registration is now offered whereby coaches that are
 not registered with a specific team this season can register with the ORA and substitute with any

Coaching Clinics

- Both CI and CSI clinics have already been set up around the Region and those planning to coach and in need of qualifications can begin to go online and register.

- Note that all CSI clinics are just one day and all CI clinics are two days over the weekend.
- Coaches must register via the Ringette Canada Coaching site in order to attend a clinic. To
 register for either clinic log on to the Ringette Canada Coaching site. Once logged into your
 profile First, complete the Coach Initiation Emodule. If you have previously completed the
 Introduction to Coaching or complete the CSI clinic prior to 2015 you are not required to
 complete this Emodule. Second, complete the corresponding online Coaching Workbook and
 Third, select clinic to attend to complete the registration process

Available PD Opportunities

- Coach Initiation in Sport module is now offered by the Coaching Association of Canada and will
 officially replace the Ringette Introduction to Coaching Course. The module takes approximately
 1 hour to complete. You can find it http://coach.ca/coach-initiation-in-sport-s17259. Coaches
 who complete the module, who do not require it (already have completed NCCP coaching
 courses) will receive PD points.
- As part of the Responsible Coaching Movement, Ringette Canada now has a partnership with the Respect in Sport group. Coaches can complete the Respect in Sport training through a Ringette Canada customized portal for activity leaders. Completion of the online training module is eligible for professional development points towards their NCCP maintenance of certification. The ORA has spent significant time on creating a new ORA Policy with respect to concussions. The Recommendations made to the board and presented at the ORA AGM can be found at http://ontario-ringette.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/07/ORA-Concussion-Committee-Final-Recommendations.pdf. The final policy will be available in the next couple weeks once approved by the Board at their next meeting. In addition a recommendation has been made to make it mandatory for all bench staff to complete the Making Headway emodule as part of this new policy and we wait to see if this recommendation is approved.
