The biggest project we worked on was our Skills Matrix Program;

Skills Matrix Information

Based on feedback from our Associations, Sport Development has updated the Skills Matrix to;

- 1- Make it easier to deliver
- 2- Make it easier to evaluate
- 3- Make it easier to record your scores

The Skills Matrix has now been divided into 2 different evaluations. One of U8/U9 and one for U10/U12. The Drill outlines, Drill diagrams and Evaluation Templates have all been sent to each association President and are also available on the ORA website at https://ontario-ringette.com/resources/sports-development/

The Skills Matrix evaluations are mandatory for all U8, U9, U10 and U12 teams. The first set must be completed by October 20th and submitted to me by October 31st. The second set is due to be submitted by March 31st. Please ensure you have set aside ice and recruited volunteers to help you with this!
