## G&T Report September 2015

Welcome back to the Rinks!

Provincial level teams were formed last spring, with some being finalized in the fall, and the Regional teams are beginning to be firmed up.

# <u>A/AA:</u>

## Tournaments:

G&T is continuing the process of assigning tournaments for these divisions. For the most part this is working well, but there are always a few teams not happy with their assignments.

It is important to remember that the tournaments you submit are the tournaments you are assigned. If you don't want tournament X, do not include it on your list.

The goal of the assignments is 2-fold: maximize exposure to other teams (especially AA with assigned ranking games), and ensure that the tournament divisions are viable, and as fairly distributed as possible.

Of approximately 80 teams assigned to 3-5 tournaments each, we have been have received 4 complaints (5%). Unfortunately not all have been resolved to the team's satisfaction.

I would like to remind teams that prior to assignments, we were having problems with late season tournaments folding, and teams scrambling to meet their requirements to attend provincials. In addition the previous AA process was ranking tournaments (with all ranking games). The revised system allows the teams choice, something that I personally believe is the most important factor.

While the system is not perfect, we continue to strive for improvements each year.

I would like to personally thank Phil Singeris who attended the August G&T Standing Committee meeting in my absence and assisted with some of the tournament assignments.

U12 teams: 5 tournaments including Provincials or Regionals
U12 Players: 7 tournaments including Provincials and/or Regionals (for 2-team players)\*
